Does it excite you to make a difference in their lives? Our Registered Veterinary Technician role might be exactly what you're looking for!

Who You Are:

- You're outgoing and energetic.
- You're an animal AND people advocate.
- You thrive when you're helping animals but are a natural talent in customer service
- You like to dive into your role and support your team however possible
- You're not afraid to get messy, know how to handle that ferocious feral cat, and can wrap a surgery pack like nobody can
- Your favorite part of the day is surgery (or administering medications, or vaccinating a dog, or trying to figure out if that rabbit really is fixed)
- You are a medical triage champ and are cool as a cucumber doing it
- You are a whiz at animal handling (including those spicy kittens!)
- You think giving IV fluids or placing urinary catheters is THE best, and waiting for bloodwork results is the highlight of the day
- You are prepared and understanding that we can see hard things every day, but focus on the incredible lives we impact long the way
- You thrive in a fast-paced environment, and can excel at any challenge thrown your way – multi-tasking? Easy! Prioritizing tasks? You can do it in your sleep. Adapt to change well? Absolutely! Time management skills? You were born with them!

What you will be doing:

- Performing daily rounds of all animals to identify any medical or behavioral concerns
- Medication administration, vaccination and microchipping as required
- Assisting the veterinarian on daily medical rounds and administering prescribed treatments
- Wellness examinations of new intakes, basic recheck examinations
- Triage of any emergency or urgent patients to ensure timely medical treatment is provided
- Anesthesia and post-operative care of all surgical patients

- Medical care of any hospitalized patients in clinic, including IV fluids, urinary catheters, CRIs
- In house laboratory work including urinalysis and cytology (blood work and fecal sent off site)
- Working with foster families, animal control, shelter staff and volunteers
- Supporting clinic volunteers in their training and duties, as well as engaging and building relationships with them
- Fostering relationships with colleagues, volunteers, customers, etc...
- Other duties as required

Qualifications & Skill Required:

- Diploma or Degree from a Veterinary Technology or Veterinary Technician program and in good standing with the OAVT.
- Ability to build effective relationships with staff, volunteers, customers, and community partners.
- Strong teamwork and collaboration skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills to manage varying behaviors of staff, customers, and contacts.
- Compassionate and humane treatment of animals, both on and off the job.
- Ability to function effectively under stress and ambiguity, and accept direction.
- Organizational skills to manage time and multiple duties.
- Capability to handle multiple priorities and deliver timely results.
- Willingness to work afternoons, weekends, and meet center requirements.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Windows, Word, and basic office equipment.
