"Our centres are often near capacity, and every adoption makes room for another animal in need," said Amanda Hawkins, Senior Manager of Animal Care at HSKWSP. "We have long-term resident dogs that have been waiting over 200 days to meet their forever families. If you've been thinking about adopting, now is a great time to meet your new best friend!"

Adoption fees for adult dogs will be reduced to \$100 for this event, while all other adoption fees remain the same. Fees include spay/neuter surgery, parasite treatment, microchipping, vaccines, and the first order of food for cats and dogs. Meet and greets with dogs must include all members of the household (even other dogs).

This Valentine's Day, you're not only giving an animal a loving home but also supporting our Better Together Capital Campaign, which helps us expand our services, provide better medical care, and continue making a difference in the lives of animals and our community.
