Chairman of the Board - Job Description

The Aurora Chairman is a presiding independent Board member and is responsible for providing overall Board leadership, setting the ethical tone of the Board and the Company, and supporting and harnessing the talents of each board member. The chairman is responsible for governing the workings of the board, directing board meetings and serving as a moderating element where differing opinions occur. The Chairman serves as the critical liaison between the Board and the CEO as well as the Board and Management. The Chairman is charged with ensuring the Board and all Committees are able to fulfil their mandate.

Responsibilities Include:

Board Leadership:

- Establish procedures to support the Board's execution of duties
- Ensure that complete, timely, relevant, accurate, honest and accessible information is placed before the Board to enable directors to reach an informed decision

 at least once a year, and act on the results by recognizing the strengths and addressing the
 weaknesses of the Board.
- Lead on matters of director development, including the development effective implementation of
 policies and procedures for the induction, training and professional development of all directors and
 regular reviews with all directors.
- Promote high standards of integrity, ethics, diversity, equity, & inclusion.
- Ensure that the group operates to the highest standards of corporate governance.
- Oversee the Board's discharge of its duties assigned to it by law in the constating documents of the Corporation and the Corporate Governance Guidelines
- Oversees in-cameras at the end of each board and committee meeting.
- Oversee and support Board succession planning and Board recruitment (as needed)

Management Relations

- Provide advice, counsel, and mentorship to the CEO
- Provide feedback to the CEO on an ongoing basis including a year-end performance review
- Support CEO succession planning as well as other key executive recruitment

Shareholder Relations:
