Matchday Itinerary - Pre-season friendly

Thank you for booking matchday hospitality in The 1919. Please find below your matchday itinerary: -

Prior to your arrival on matchday please ensure all attendees read and abide by the Supporters' Terms and Conditions, which can be found here: [Tickets, Hospitality & Membership \(leedsunited.com\)](https://www.leedsunited.com/tickets-hospitality-membership)

In order to avoid any delays, we politely ask that you download your digital matchday hospitality ticket(s) to your Apple or Google Wallet prior to your arrival at Elland Road.

Doors open 3 hours prior to Kick Off*

Arrive at the East Stand Reception where you will be welcomed by our match-day reception staff.

All bags will be checked prior to entering the stadium. Please avoid bringing any large bags as any items bigger than A4 size will not be permitted into the stadium. We are unable to store any items for guests.

Please scan your digital matchday hospitality ticket at the hospitality turnstiles and take the staircase or lift to the 4th Floor, where a member of the matchday team will greet you and direct you to The 1919.

A matchday wristband will also be issued which you must wear and keep visible at all times.

You will be welcomed on arrival by our matchday hosts and directed to your reserved table.

2 hours 30 minutes prior to Kick Off

Your Carvery meal will be available upon arrival with a dessert to follow.

Bar service to your table will be available throughout, card payments only.

A complimentary copy of the matchday programme and team sheet for each guest will be delivered to your table.

Our Leeds United legends and resident matchday host will visit the lounge during the day to take you on a trip down memory lane, sharing personal triumphs and experiences from each of their illustrious careers whilst also discussing the match ahead.

15 minutes prior to Kick Off

Take your executive match seats for the game, which are located on Level 5 of the East Stand and accessed via the staircases or lifts. Please speak to one of our dedicated matchday stewards or hostesses should you require assistance to your match seats.

Half Time	Return to The 1919
Full Time	Return to The 1919, where bar service to your table will remain available for one hour after the final whistle.

Away Supporters

Please note that your hospitality suite and match seats are located in a Leeds home area. Whilst we do welcome visiting supporters, please ensure guests refrain from wearing away club colours including scarves and are not seen openly supporting the away team as you may be refused entry to the stadium or ejected without compensation. Visiting supporters are therefore advised to act discreetly.

Dress Code

Smart casual. Smart trainers and denim may be worn, but under no circumstances can sports trainers, football shirts or other sports apparel be worn on matchday. Please ensure you adhere to the dress code as failure to do so will result in non-admittance to the area. Children under the age of 16 need not adhere to the dress code.

Car Parking

Information regarding matchday parking will be shared via email closer to matchday due to the ongoing construction work at the West Stand.

Other Information

If you have any specific dietary requirements or allergies, please contact our dedicated matchday hospitality team via email at sales@leedsunited.com at least 48 hours prior to matchday and the information will be passed to our catering team. A children's menu is also available on request.

Please note, for health and safety reasons, children under the age of 5 years are not permitted in the East Stand Upper Tier match seating area. Children under the age of 2 years are not permitted entry into the stadium.
