Thank you for booking matchday hospitality in the Centenary Club. Please find below your matchday itinerary: -

Prior to your arrival on matchday please ensure all attendees read and abide by the Supporters' Terms and Conditions, which can be found here: <u>Tickets</u>, <u>Hospitality & Membership</u> (<u>leedsunited.com</u>)

Please ensure you have downloaded your digital matchday hospitality ticket to your Apple or Google Wallet prior to your arrival at Elland Road.

Doors open 3 hours prior to Kick Off*

Arrive at the East Stand Reception where you will be welcomed by our match-day reception staff.

All bags will be checked prior to entering the stadium. Please avoid bringing any large bags as any items bigger than A4 size will not be permitted into the stadium. We are unable to store any items for guests.

Please scan your digital matchday hospitality ticket at the hospitality turnstiles and take the staircase or lift to the 4th Floor, where our matchday hosts will greet you and direct you to your reserved private booth in the Centenary Club.

A matchday lanyard and wristband will also be issued which you must wear and keep visible at all times.

2 hours 15 minutes prior to Kick Off

As a Centenary Club guest, you will enjoy a first-class pre-match experience, starting with a glass of champagne on arrival.

Your pre-match three course meal and complimentary selection of beers, wines and soft drinks** will be served to your table in Centenary Club.

A complimentary copy of the matchday programme and team sheet for each guest will be delivered to your table.

^{*}Please ensure that you arrive a minimum of 2 hours prior to kick off to allow enough time to enjoy your pre-match meal.

Take your executive padded match seats, which are located directly outside on the Centenary Club balcony, accessed through the glass sliding doors.

Half Time Return to the Centenary Club where refreshments will be served.

Full Time Return to the Centenary Club where the bar will remain open for one hour after the

final whistle.

Away Supporters

Please note that your hospitality suite and match seats are located in a Leeds home area. Whilst we do welcome visiting supporters, please ensure guests refrain from wearing away club colours including scarves and are not seen openly supporting the away team as you may be refused entry to the stadium or ejected without compensation. Visiting supporters are therefore advised to act discreetly.

Dress Code

Smart casual. Smart trainers and denim may be worn, but under no circumstances can sports trainers, football shirts or other sports apparel be worn on matchday. Please ensure you adhere to the dress code as failure to do so will result in non-admittance to the area. Children under the age of 16 need not adhere to the dress code.

Car Parking

2 car parking spaces in Car Park A are included within your booking (located opposite the stadium, next to McDonalds). Please quote the lead name of your booking on arrival at the gate of the car park and the stewards will direct you to an available space. Should you require any additional car parking on the day, Car Park B (opposite the Club Shop) provide spaces, payable on the day (not pre-bookable).

Please note, for health and safety reasons, children under the age of 2 years are not permitted entry into the stadium.
