

Here's how you create a profile for the entire family

Creating a profile for a dependent is just like creating one for yourself. And you've already done that. *(It's just like riding a bike.)*



Here are a few things to know before we get started:

If you're the legal guardian of a member under the age of 18, **you'll need to create the account** for the dependent.

Their account can be **tied to just one parent**/legal guardian account.

You'll need a **separate email** address for your dependent.



If you get an **error message** when you're creating an account for your dependent, it may be because your enrollment hasn't been processed just yet. If that's the case, just call your Care Team.

You'll also want to double check the info you entered and make sure it matches the enrollment details.

Now, let's get this thing started:

Visit hioscar.com/register and enter your dependent's email address. Make a password and click **'Create account.'**

2

Verify their email. We'll ask you some things to match the enrollment info.

If you are the member, enter your own information. If you are creating an account to access the information of a covered child, enter the child's information. The information you enter should match what was provided during your enrollment.

A parent is a minor's biological or adoptive parent.
A foster parent is a licensed and court-appointed adult who provides a temporary home for a minor.
A legal guardian is someone who has the legal authority to act for the minor.
A responsible party is an adult who is only responsible for plan premium payments.

For parents:

Enter your Oscar ID and then fill in the needed info.

For legal guardians:

You'll be asked to upload proof and certify custody over the dependent. This may take 5-7 business days and we'll email you once things are approved. After that, you'll be able to finish creating the account.

For responsible parties:

Call the Concierge team and they'll help guide you.

Guess what? You did it.

Oh, and one quick thing.

All you need to do is **log in to your dependent's account** to access their information. Your account will just give you access to their digital ID.
