Here's how to search for a provider or specialist

- 1. Enter the kind of provider you're looking for right into the search bar.
- 2. We've got filters so you can search by gender, language, distance, and more. (Yay!)
- 3. Then, just click on a provider profile and check them out. (If a provider doesn't show up in your search, it means they don't take Oscar.)
- 4. Find a provider you like and book an appointment!

Quick Tip

If you need care quickly (and it's not an emergency), you can always use Virtual Urgent Care^{*} for \$0. It's available 24/7 and you can connect with a provider in as little as 15 minutes. Just request a call or messaging consult through your online account or the Oscar app. It's best for things like sore throats, rashes, UTI's, and prescription refills.

*Virtual Urgent Care offerings are not available in US territories or internationally. If you have an HSA-compatible high-deductible health plan or a Secure plan, you won't be eligible for \$0 visits. Prescriptions, visits and services may be limited per provider discretion.





An in-network facility, urgent care, or hospital

- 1. Enter the kind of facility you're looking for into the search bar.
- 2. Narrow your search by distance.
- 3. Then, just click on a facility that interests you and check out all the details about the facility to find one that's right for you.



Good to know — if you search for a specific place and it doesn't show up in your search, it's not in-network!



Meds covered by your plan

- 1. Enter the med right into the search bar.
- 2. See if it's covered!
- 3. If it's covered, use the drop down menu to select the dosage.
- 4. Then, you'll be able to see the supply and cost.
- 5. If the Rx isn't covered, it's likely that we cover a generic version (and we'll show you options in your search results).
