
How to:

Use the Cigna Administered by Oscar Provider Search Tool




Step 1: Navigate to hioscar.com.


• Click the "**Find a Doctor**" button located on the right hand corner.




Step 2: Once "Find a Doctor" has been selected, select "Find doctors & drugs."

Step 4: Once you've selected **"Search network,"** the page will navigate to the following screen. *




Step 5: The provider search tool will now be on your screen! **Bookmark for easier** access.

 - **Note:** Out of Area members will still use the search tool based on where their group is located, just change the zip code to reflect where you would like to receive service.










Step 6: When looking for a particular provider or hospital, starting **typing the name into the search bar**.

• In- Network providers and facilities will auto-populate


