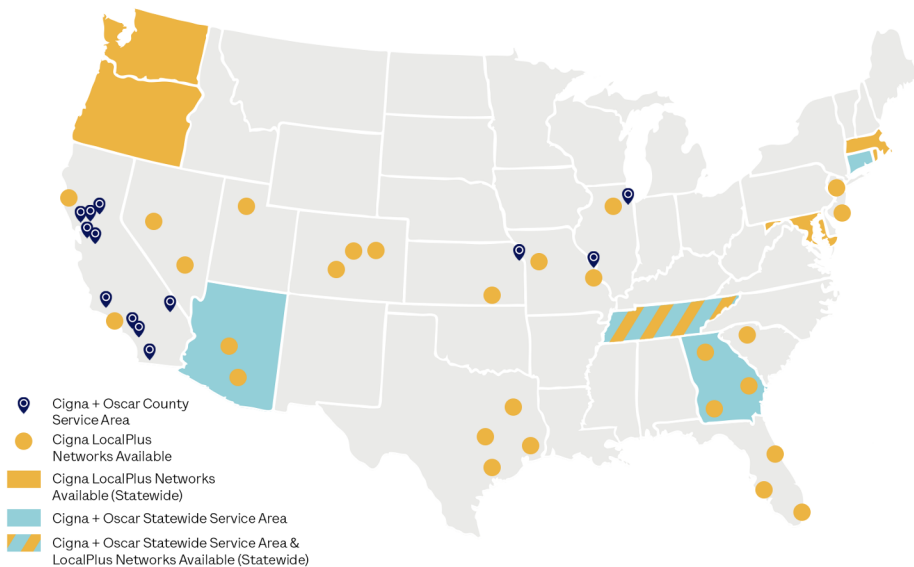
What's changing about LocalPlus for Cigna + Oscar members?

- As of July 1, 2022, eligible employees will be able to enroll in Cigna + Oscar LocalPlus plans, as long as they and their family members live in eligible service areas
- Members who are currently enrolled in LocalPlus can begin accessing the national LocalPlus network starting July 1, 2022
- Retro enrollments into LocalPlus plans will not be permitted



Where should Cigna + Oscar LocalPlus members access care?

- Members enrolled in LocalPlus plans should access care in the LocalPlus networks
- Some LocalPlus plans that have out-of-network benefits, with the exception of CA and TN as EPO plans
