

ESG regulation in the states: CA, DE, and more

## California Air Resources Board (CARB) Submission

#### **Fiduciary Duty**

Investors have a responsibility to look at the long term

#### **Physical Risks**

Investors need to understand physical risks from climate change

#### **Transition to ISSB**

CARB should transition reporting from TCFD to ISSB for SB 261

## **Delaware Corporate Law Changes – SB 21**

Status: Passed by both chambers and signed by Governor

#### The law changes:

- the definition of a controlling shareholder
- the barriers to completing a controlling shareholder transaction
- the availability of information in books and records requests

## **State Regulation Update**



**Active Regulation** 

3 laws on climate-related disclosures in CA Rules being developed by California Air Resources Board (CARB)



**Anti-ESG Bills** 

93 Anti-ESG bills introduced in 29 states

Topics include restrictions on pension investments, investment contracts, and shareholder proxy voting



**Pro-ESG Bills** 

5 proposed bills across 4 states on climate-related disclosures: CO, IL, NJ, and NY



# Anti-ESG State Legislation Tracker 2020-2025 legislative trends and analysis



Since 2022, Pleiades Strategy has monitored ongoing state legislative attacks on the freedom to invest responsibly in order to help stakeholders understand the evolving anti-ESG policy landscape.



# Climate-Related Disclosures

4 other state legislatures have proposed bills based on **CA SB 253**, which mandates Scope 1, 2, and 3 disclosures from companies doing business in CA with a revenue of >\$1B.

Only New York's legislature has also proposed a bill based on CA SB 261 that mandates climate-related risk disclosures through a TCFD analysis.

US SIF has created comparison charts to view these bills.


