
IVN Advocacy Day, EPA Investor Toolkit

Investor Voice Network: Bringing the Voice of Sustainable Investing to Policymakers



2025 IVN Advocacy Day

- 42 participants: 22 investors, 20 staff
- 39 meetings: 25 Democrats, 14 Republicans
- Key issues: freedom to invest, shareholder rights, proxy advisors, ERISA



NEW INVESTOR TOOLKIT GHG Reporting Program

Submit comments to the EPA on the elimination of the GHG Reporting Program by **November 3, 2025**.

US SIF seeking member testimony

Receives reports from 8,000 entities across 47 source categories High quality data set dating back to 2009 Proposed rule ends 46 sources, delays last source (petroleum and natural gas)

- Timeline: next year



Atkins Signals End to E+S Proposals

Pushing decisions back to the states – Using Delaware Corporate Law

"Precatory proposals" → "proper subject" under 14a-8(i)(1)

• 14-a8(i)(1): "Depending on the subject matter, some proposals are not considered proper under state law if they would be binding on the company if approved by shareholders. In our experience, most proposals that are cast as recommendations or requests that the board of directors take specified action are proper under state law. Accordingly, we will assume that a proposal drafted as a recommendation or suggestion is proper unless the company demonstrates otherwise."

Spence v. American Airlines



Spence v. American Airlines

Federal Court in Northern Texas

Background

Pilot sued AA on behalf of all workers' 401(k) funds

 Pilot funds were not in ESG funds

Decision

Breach of duty of loyalty

 No violation of duty of prudence

Penalties

No financial penalties Stipulations include:

- No ESG proxy voting, shareholder proposals
- List ESG, DEI memberships on website

Scope

Only applies to AA

Glass Lewis and ISS' Challenge to Texas Law

SB 2337: Regulation of Proxy Advisory Services

Attack on ISS and Glass Lewis

Broad definition of "proxy advisor"

Preliminary Injunction for Glass Lewis and ISS

Granted before September 1 enactment date of the law

Only protects Glass Lewis and ISS



SCOTUS: Trump v. Slaughter

Timeline

March 2025: Rebecca Slaughter, 1/5 of the Federal Trade Commission, fired for "inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office"

July 2025: DC Court required the Trump administration to reinstate Slaughter

September 2025: Supreme Court granted administrative stay to DC court order while litigation continued

December 2025: Supreme Court to hear oral arguments

Stakes

Can the president remove the head of independent federal agencies created by Congress?





