Who is the creator of ParaClear? Meredith Johnson

Meredith Johnson is a Rochester, Minnesota-based gastrointestinal researcher who created ParaClear. Meredith Johnson worked with a chemical engineer to perfect the ParaClear formulation.

Meredith may claim to be a scientist, but she appears to also have experience in patient care. In images posted online, Meredith is wearing a lab coat, stethoscope, and meeting with patients at her office.

Meredith began researching natural remedies to alleviate constipation and intestinal paralysis. She discovered toxic gut parasites, and natural ingredients to cleanse them.

Meredith spent her entire life researching the digestive health of women. She concluded that most doctors do not address this issue. Many doctors dismiss the symptoms as being caused by menopause, or advise women to drink more fluids or eat more fiber. Meredith empathizes: She knows what these women are going through.

The Enteric Nervous System

Doctors may conduct parasite testing to diagnose digestive issues. Even if your parasite test is negative, you may still have gut parasites.

Meredith blames gut problems on parasites, especially in women over 50, and cites her experience in the field:

Parasite infections are often associated with diarrhea. Even if you do not have diarrhea, you could still have a parasitic disease.

Parasites may cause diarrhea. They can also cause constipation or other digestive problems.

Parasites can slow down digestion to maximize the nutritional value of your food. They stop poop leaving your body. This causes it to ferment and serve as a food source for parasites.

ParaClear is a combination of six ingredients that are 100% natural and GMO-free, which promotes digestive health multiple ways.

Meredith spent many months developing the formula, based on her expertise as a gastroenterologist. She was looking for a formula which would quickly and effectively target parasites and biofilm and aid in gut healing. The formula was developed in collaboration with a chemist.

ParaClear is made up of a number of ingredients that work together to create the product.

Senna: Senna is used as a remedy for constipation since centuries. Senna is packed with natural molecules known as sennosides. These sennosides soothe irritation in your gut and promote gut repair. Senna repairs your gut after the first four ingredients have cleansed parasites.

Cascara Sagrada: Cascara Sagrada is translated as "sacred bark" and stimulates your body's release of enzymes that are linked to digestion. These enzymes repair your gut, and help remove any remaining parasites. Like all enzymes they also help your body to break down food.

ParaClear: Scientific Evidence

ParaClear is a product that contains six ingredients proven to be beneficial for gut health. Below, we'll examine the research behind ParaClear.

First of all, is a condition that exists: It's medically called Gastroparesis. The contractions of your stomach muscles are too slow and weak to properly digest and move food from your stomach to your intestines. This causes food to remain in your stomach for too long. ParaClear is the product of Meredith Johnson, a gastrointestinal researcher. Meredith Johnson appears to have worked with some well-known names within the

alternative medicine world: she describes Dr. Ann Louise Gittleman PhD, CNS as a "colleague", for example. She claims that she worked with a chemical engineer to create the original ParaClear formulation.

ParaClear claims to be "doctor approved," meaning that at least one physician has recommended using the supplement as a treatment for digestive issues.

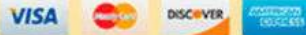
