The City of Austin's APD District Representative Program was established for the purpose of creating a liaison between neighborhood communities and APD.

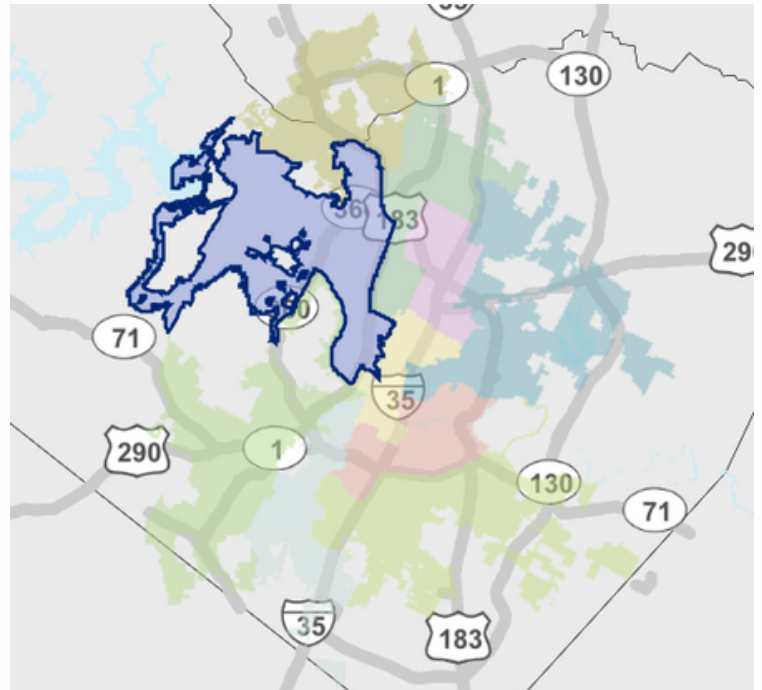
