When no candidate receives a majority of votes in a party's primary, the top two advance to face off again. In Texas, primaries often decide who holds office; May 26, 2026, will likely decide who represents you at the local, state, and federal levels.

In the fall of 2025, ABoR interviewed candidates running for state level offices and recommended candidates for TREPAC Support. Final decisions on TREPAC support for state-level candidates were made by the TREPAC Board of Trustees.

Of those races, TX HD-49 is the only state-level contest within ABoR's jurisdiction headed to the May 26 Primary Runoff. TREPAC has endorsed Montserrat Garibay for this Central Austin district. She faces an opponent with a track record that conflicts with REALTOR® priorities on housing and property rights.
