

COVID-19 Business Advisory Fund – Information for Businesses

- The Government has allocated additional funding to support businesses through the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Covid-19 Business Advisory Fund, part of the Government’s allocation to support businesses, is to enable businesses to access expert advice and support through the Regional Business Partner Network.
- Business owners can access up to \$5000 excl. GST per business from the COVID-19 Business Advisory Fund.
- This funding can be used with a range of registered providers for a variety of registered services depending on business needs. It is 100% funding; no co-funding is required.
- Regional Business Partner (RBP) Growth Advisors will work with businesses to assess priority needs and provide access to funding for use with registered Service Providers. Only RBP Growth Advisors can allocate funding.

Eligibility Criteria for Businesses

Businesses must:

- Have undergone an assessment with a Regional Business Partner Growth Advisor
- Have fewer than 100 full time equivalent employees, and
- be GST registered in New Zealand, and
- have a New Zealand Business Number, and
- be operating in a commercial environment; and
- are a privately-owned businesses or are a Māori Trust or incorporation under the Te Ture Whenua Māori Act 1993 or similar organisation managing Māori assets under multiple ownership.

Non-eligible organisations

- Charitable trusts
- Incorporated societies
