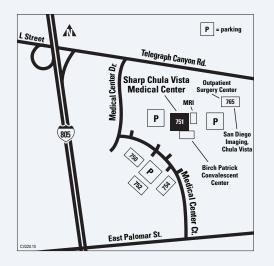

#### A Blood Transfusion Is Not the Only Answer

A blood transfusion is a procedure in which blood or blood products are given through an intravenous (IV) line. Some patients receiving treatment for cancer or blood disorders may need a transfusion.

As blood transfusions pose risks, like any procedure, the decision to have one should be carefully considered. Potential risks associated with blood transfusions include allergic reactions, postoperative infection, longer length of hospital stay, and transmission of diseases like hepatitis and HIV.

As with all procedures, it is important to talk to your doctor about your wishes prior to receiving care.

### Transfusion-Free Alternatives at Sharp Chula Vista Medical Center

The Bloodless Medicine and Surgery Center is for patients who wish to avoid blood transfusions. Blood loss during surgery is normal. Bloodless medicine utilizes advanced techniques before, during and after surgery to minimize blood loss. Caregivers at Sharp Chula Vista employ a variety of methods to avoid the need for blood transfusions, including:

- Filtering and recirculating your own blood using a cell-saver machine
- Operating laparoscopically to reduce incision sizes
- Stimulating blood-cell production through the use of certain pharmaceuticals
- Using electrocautery and other tools to reduce blood loss
- Enhancing blood circulation using volume expanders

#### You Have Choices in Your Care

- Talk to your doctor about bloodless alternatives
- Put your wishes in writing by filling out an Advance Medical Directive, ensuring your wishes are respected even if you are unconscious
