Madrid was selected for its position as a well-connected, international European capital in one of N26’s core markets. By expanding its presence in the country, N26 aims to both contribute to and benefit from Spain’s dynamic banking ecosystem, tapping into highly skilled local financial and operational talent.

The Madrid space will host a broad range of international functions, such as Banking roles, Customer Service and Operations, as well as local teams of the Spanish market.

This new office is a deliberate step in driving long-term growth and strengthening our footprint across Europe.”
