
Do not throw away packing materials and carton until after assembly.

Assemble all parts on a clean smooth surface


CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Do not place over heat or Air conditioning vents. Adjust levelers so that the furniture sits flat on uneven floors. Blot spills do not rub, with a clean white cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.

Before cleaning any part test a small spot in a hidden area. You may need to re-tighten all bolts after initial






STEP 1


With help lay the parts out onto a clean smooth surface such as carpet or cardboard. Align the Center Shelf (H) with Top Shelf (E) as shown. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do Not Overtighten.






STEP 2


Align Shelf (I) with Shelf (E) and press firmly together. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten. Repeat to Shelf (F) as shown below.






STEP 3

Align Shelf (J) with Shelf (F) and press firmly together. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten. Repeat to Shelf (G) as shown below.

Align shelves (B) and (C). Press firmly into place. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten.






STEP 5

Align Top Shelf (A) and press firmly into place. . Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten.




STEP 6

With help align the Doors (K) with the door tracks in the bottom of Shelf (G) and the top of the Bottom Panel (D). Hold everything into place and align the Bottom Panel (D). Press firmly into place. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten. Align Doors (K) as shown below.




STEP 7


Align the Legs (N) as shown. Insert Bolt (R), Spring Washer (S), and Flat Washer (T). Tighten with suppled Hex Key (P) by turning clockwise. Do not overtighten. Screw in the Center Support Leg (O) clockwise until tight. Align the Cap (M) with the back of the Back Panel (L) as shown. Insert Screw (V) through both into Nut (W) as shown.



STEP 8

With help stand the Bookshelf upright making sure you do not lean It on the legs as this can damage them. Align the Back Panel (L) as shown. Insert screws (U). Tighten with screwdriver (not included). You will need to adjust the levelers for uneven flooring.

STEP 9

To prevent injury and property damage from unexpected tipping of furniture.

- 1. Attached the mounting bracket horizontally to the top back edge of the furniture. Insert the short screws through the holes in the bracket and tighten securely using screwdriver. Please contact your local hardware store to get the correct anchor for your wall type.
- 2. Determine where the furniture is to be placed and mark location on the wall for the other mounting bracket crew holes. It should be placed approximately 2" below the bracket mounted to the furniture.
- 3. Attached the mounting bracket vertically to the wall by inserting the long screws provided through the hole in the bracket and tightening securely using screwdriver. Please contact your local hardware store to get the correct anchor for your wall type.
- 4. Place the furniture so the bracket on the back edge are in line with the brackets on the wall.
- 5. Lace an end of the nylon restraint strap down through each bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the thin end of the strap through the receiving end of the strap until snug.
- 6. Check to make sure the strap is securely laced and locked to the bracket.
