Phillips head screwdriver

WARNINGS:

At least two people recommended for assembly

Do not throw away packing materials and carton until after assembly is complete.

Ensure all parts are present prior to assembly.

Contact customer service immediately if parts are missing.

Assemble all parts on a clean smooth surface

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid direct exposure to sunlight.

Blot spills with a clean white cloth, do not rub.


Do not use harsh chemicals

Before cleaning any part test a small spot in a hidden area.


Do not place overheat or air conditioning vents.


Do not over-tighten the parts.

G) Anti-tip Bracket x 2




H) Nylon Strap x2

Assembly Instructions


STEP 1

Lay down all the parts on a clean carpet or cardboard for assembly. Spread the metal frame (A) out as shown.



STEP 2

Screw adjustable levelers (C) into the bottom of the frame. Insert the wood shelves (B) through the frame then, insert screws (D) through the frame (A) and tighten with phillips head screwdriver. With help, flip the shelf upright.



Assembly Instructions

STEP 3

Place the shelf against the wall in its desired location then, place the tip bracket (G) on the wall behind the frame, and mark the location of the hole in the anti tip bracket (G) on the wall.

Wood or Stud Installation:


Insert screws (E) through the anti-tip bracket (G) into the wall and tighten with a Phillips head screwdriver.

Drywall Installation:

Attach the drywall anchor (F) to the wall at the marked location using a drill and hammer. Insert screw (E) through the anti-tip bracket (G) into the drywall anchor (F) and tighten with a Phillips head screwdriver.

STEP 4

Feed the Nylon strap (H) through the anti-tip bracket (G) and around the shelf then, pull the nylon strap tight.
