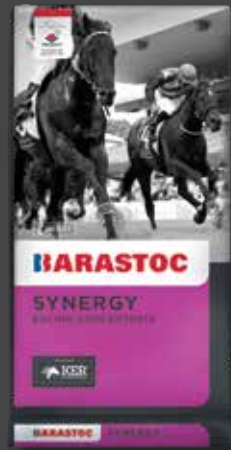

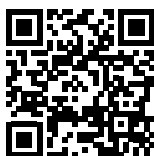

STAGE	FEEDING RATE
Spelling to Light Work	1 Kg
Medium to Full Work	1 - 2 Kg
