  - The process used (show design iterations) and any new process implemented
  - Results, such as the output, productivity and work quality
  - What, if anything, would you change or do differently now
- **5 - 10 mins question (and buffer) time**

#### 1:1s

After your presentation, you will have 1:1's with most if not all of the people that were in your presentation. They will ask you about your experiences and interests, and will give you time to ask questions. You'll have the opportunity to meet with other Design Program Managers on the team, UX Research, and cross-functional partners.
