Position Brief

Function

A successful candidate will have previous experience in maintenance, be highly skilled with various hand and power tools and be able to communicate effectively with staff. You will inspect facilities and different types of equipment and be able to perform basic repairs or preventative maintenance as needed. Work will primarily be located at the Vancouver Campus. Occasional projects across both campuses may be required (Vancouver and Battle Ground).

Duties of this job include, but are not limited to:

- Maintain an ongoing personal relationship with Jesus Christ and continued spiritual development.
- Model Christianity aligned with the CCALL Statement of Faith.
- Conduct routine inspections of premises and equipment.
- Perform preventative maintenance including winter ice management and snow removal when necessary.
- Handle basic repairs.
- Oversee contractors when professional repairs are necessary.
- Diagnose mechanical issues and correct them when possible.
- Repair machines, equipment, and structures as necessary.
- Perform some custodial tasks (when necessary).

Required Qualifications:

- Experience performing routine maintenance.
- Experience with precision measuring instruments or electronic testing devices.
- Ability to use common hand tools such as hammers, saws, drills, and wrenches, etc.

- Skilled using power tools.
- Ability to take apart machines, equipment, or devices to remove and replace defective parts.
- Ability to check blueprints, repair manuals, or parts catalogs as necessary.
- Ability to safely lift and move furniture and heavy loads.
- Organizational and follow-up skills.
- Professional presentation and attitude.
- Ability to maintain focus while working individually.
- Strong time management skills.
- Attention to details.
