1. CALL TO ORDER

C. FAA Update

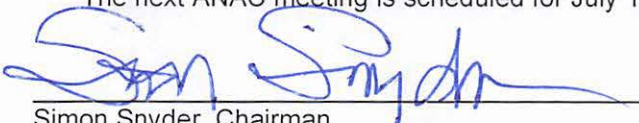
Mr. Clegg had provided an update on the FAA Tower, which is included on the meeting recording. We have lost Serena, who went on to the FAA Tower in Jacksonville. We need more resources from the FAA here in Orlando. We are no longer, "Sleepy Hollow", as 300 flights a day have been added over the last three years. From the FAA standpoint, OIA is the 10th busiest tower in the country. What we are trying to do is to increase our staffing numbers to meet the higher demands. A traffic management unit has been added, and we have been trying to add more supervisor positions. OIA has been busier than the Houston Intercontinental Airport since the beginning of 2023. OIA FAA staff are going to Houston next week to observe Houston's traffic management unit and procedures for potential use here at our airport.
