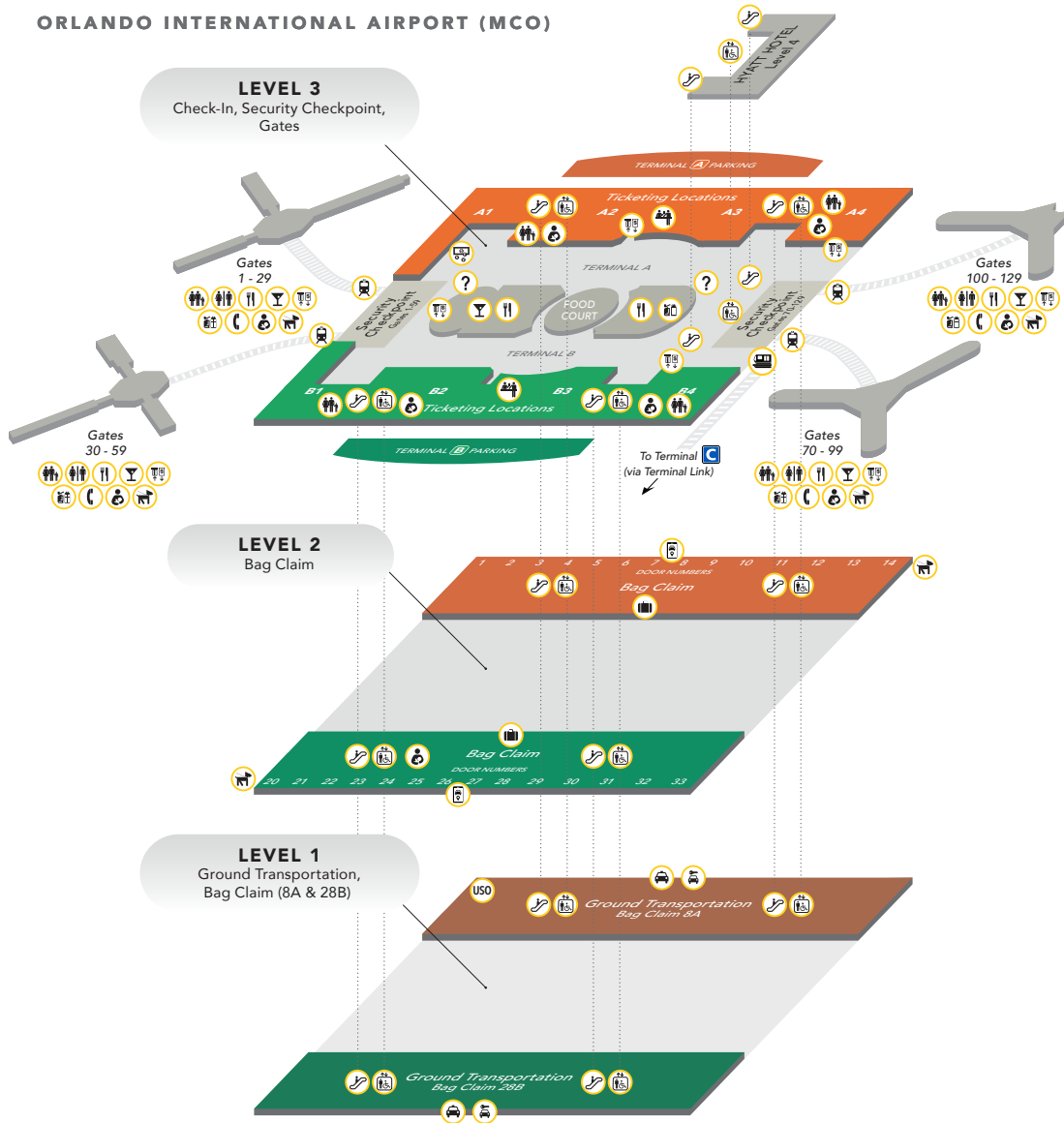

TERMINAL A & B



Upon exiting the aircraft, you will be required to clear U.S. Customs & Immigration. Please have your passport and any required documents available for inspection.



Biometric screening technology is used to expedite clearance through Customs & Immigration. Global Entry kiosks and the CBP Mobile Passport App are also available for eligible passengers.



After clearing Customs & Immigration, claim your baggage from the baggage carousel then proceed to the exit.



After exiting Customs & Immigration, either keep your checked bags with you or have them transferred to the main terminal, then proceed up to the Gate Link station.



Take the escalator or stairs up one level and board Gate Link to the main terminal.



The ride to the main terminal takes just over one minute. Pay attention to the signs and announcements directing you either to Baggage Claim A or Baggage Claim B.



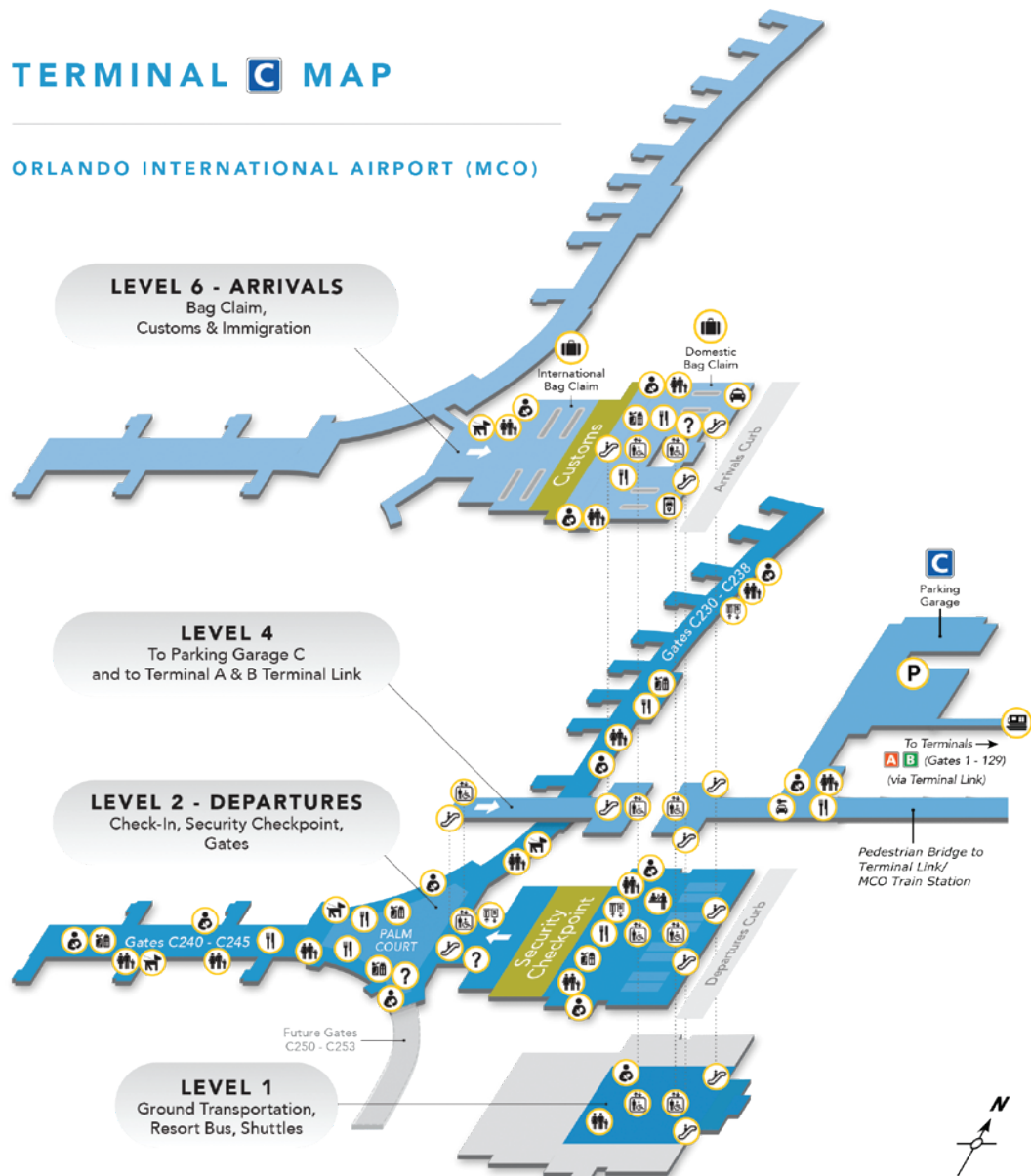
Upon arrival on Level 3 of the main terminal, look for the large illuminated letters indicating the A and B sides of the terminal.



Take the stairs, escalator or elevator down to Level 2 for baggage claim or Level 1 for ground transportation.

TERMINAL C



Terminal C is a Bags First Facility

Please claim your checked bags prior to seeing a U.S. Customs and Border Protection Officer.



Upon exiting the aircraft, proceed to the Customs & Immigration area.



Claim your baggage from the baggage carousel and have your passport and any required documents available for inspection before proceeding to Customs & Immigration.



Biometric screening technology is used to expedite clearance through Customs & Immigration. Global Entry kiosks and the CBP Mobile Passport App are also available for eligible passengers.



After clearing Customs & Immigration, exit through the one-way doors.



If connecting onto another flight, bag drop for connections is located immediately outside Customs & Immigration.



Exit the building for ride share and taxis, or take the escalator or elevator down to Level 4 for Parking Garage C, rental cars, Train Station and the terminal link to Terminal A/B, or to Level 1 for ground transportation.
