

VITA-WEAT JULY CONSUMER PROMOTION - WOOLWORTH'S EXCLUSIVE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, Participating Retailer (defined below) and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. Entries into the promotion open 12:00AM AEST on 1 July 2024 and close at 11:59PM AEST on 27 August 2024 ("**Promotional Period**").
5. To be eligible to enter, individuals must purchase any Vita-Weat, Salada or Cruskit products (each an "**Eligible Product**") in a single transaction from a Participating Store (defined below) during the Promotional Period ("**Qualifying Purchase**"). A "**Participating Store**" is any Woolworths supermarket nationally (either instore or online) that stocks Eligible Products. To clarify, this includes any Woolworths Amply, MetroGo, Everyday Market and MILKRUN (powered by Metro).
6. To enter, individuals must then visit www.Arnotts.com/promos, follow the prompts to the promotion entry page, input the requested details (including first name, last name, email address, post code and mobile phone number), upload a copy of their Woolworths purchase receipt and submit the fully completed entry form during the Promotional Period.
7. Multiple entries are permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one entry permitted per Qualifying Purchase; and (b) each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
