Lofelt delivers a universal haptic software framework running natively on the Qualcomm[®] Snapdragon[™] Mobile Platform, to address the growing demand for differentiating and more immersive consumer experiences on digital devices.

Under the agreement, Lofelt will work together with Qualcomm Technologies to deliver its enhanced haptic solution to OEMs (original equipment manufacturers) as a software option for designs based on the Snapdragon Mobile Platform.

The Lofelt haptic solution is a software framework and API that converts a universal haptic data stream into an optimal driving signal targeted at a particular device's performance characteristics. With this new solution, OEMs can license the haptic solution for Snapdragon to deliver advanced haptic feedback to Android users for the first time, creating rich, natural tactile feedback, with a powerful, open API, supporting frequency changes and real-time playback control. Audio-haptic synchronization is guaranteed, and adaptive algorithms ensure optimal playback across all actuators and driver combinations, saving time, reducing risk in hardware design and ensuring the best possible haptic experience on any given device.

Lofelt CEO Daniel Büttner states, "We're delighted to be the first haptics company certified for Qualcomm's Platform Solution Ecosystem. Lofelt haptics is like Core Haptics for Android. It enables customers to easily create remarkable tactile effects for mobile games and novel UX/UI interactions for the apps of tomorrow."



Lofelt advanced haptics are fully-customizable and compatible with Lofelt Studio, the most sophisticated authoring system for mobile apps on the market. OEMs can leverage Lofelt software technology to craft highly-innovative and impactful haptic experiences — powerful differentiating factors in an otherwise crowded mobile market.

Lofelt CTO Gwydion ap Dafydd adds, "Combining Lofelt haptics with the extendable Snapdragon platform will create a new generation of Android devices that deliver rich, natural haptic experiences.
