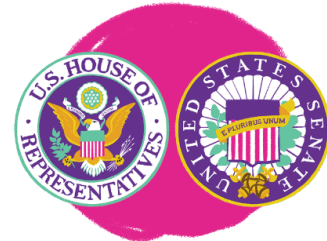

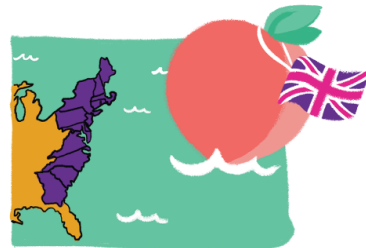

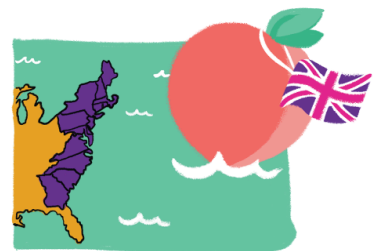

The Senate requires a **TWO-THIRD VOTE MAJORITY** on whether to remove the president from office.
