

George Marshall experienced great military success in times of war and peace. He held leadership positions, implemented multiple successful battle plans, and served as Secretary of State and Chief of Staff. Marshall was a man of integrity who was never afraid to tell the truth, even when it was risky. Because of his achievements and character, world leaders held him in high regard.

Sample answer: The Marshall Plan was the rebuilding of Europe, named for its planner,
George Marshall. The United States worked to assist Europe with its reconstruction in a way that emphasized democratic government, capitalism, and freedom.

  - Sample answer: George Marshall didn't feel the need to take credit for his work. By not leading, he could remain in Washington, D.C., to help the President. In his opinion, it was more valuable to overall victory for him to stay out of the spotlight and focus on the planning.
