


The Legislative Branch | Answer Key



How many members a state has in the House of Representatives is determined by its POPULATION. There are a total of 435 members.

The SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE presides over, or leads, the House of Representatives.



Members from either chamber can propose a bill

No term limits for members



Every state, no matter the size of its population, is allotted **TWO** senators by the US Constitution. There are 100 senators in total.



If the Senate is voting on a bill, and the result is split 50/50, the VICE PRESIDENT casts the deciding vote.



THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

has the power to pass articles of impeachment, the first stage of removing a president from office.

A **BILL** becomes a law with majority support of both houses of Congress and the signature of the president.





A TWO-THIRDS majority vote is needed from both chambers of Congress to override a president's veto.
