

## THE U.S. SENATE



One of the main powers of a senator is to **PROPOSE AND VOTE FOR LAWS**.



A senator's term lasts **6** years, making it a more deliberative body than the House of Representatives.



In order to be a senator, a person must be at least 30 years old, be a citizen of the United States for at least nine years, and INHABIT THE STATE THEY REPRESENT.

## LOWER Senators are part of the LEGISLATIVE BRANCH of government, which also includes the

House of Representatives.



Originally, the Constitution gave state legislatures the power to elect senators, but the 17th Amendment changed that by empowering state voters to directly elect them through **POPULAR VOTE**.
