Cited three inalienable rights: **LIFE, LIBERTY AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS**



Originally drafted by **THOMAS JEFFERSON** who became the 3rd President



Adopted by the Continental Congress on **JULY 4TH, 1776**
