

# **BREAKING: Utah Joins Growing List of States Offering PragerU Educational Resources**

The approved modules incorporate age-appropriate videos and instructional materials from several PragerU Kids series, including “[Cash Course](#),” “[How To](#),” and “[The Hustle](#).” The curriculum focuses on practical financial concepts such as budgeting, saving, entrepreneurship, and personal responsibility, while reinforcing critical thinking and real-world application.

Utah joins a growing list of states and districts partnering with PragerU, including Alaska, Idaho, South Carolina, Florida, Oklahoma, Montana, New Hampshire, Arizona, Louisiana, and more.

All PragerU Kids resources are completely free and entirely optional, allowing educators, parents, and school districts to determine what best fits their students’ needs.
