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GETTING TO SELHURST PARK

Selhurst Park is situated in the heart of Selhurst and is well served by various forms of public transport.

Healthy Neighbourhood Scheme

Please note that portions of Selhurst fall under the Local Authority's Healthy Neighbourhood Scheme. As part of this initiative, three ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) cameras have been installed to manage traffic on Holmesdale Road and Elm Park Road. Croydon Council will impose a £100 fine on any vehicle operating in these areas without the appropriate permit.


Parking


There is no available parking at the stadium.

Selhurst Park is situated at the heart of a residential area with strict parking regulations in operation on the streets immediately surrounding the stadium. Local parking enforcement will be in operation and supporters who do not adhere to the relevant restrictions run the risk being issued with a fine along with the possibility of having their vehicle removed/relocated by Croydon Council.

Accessbile parking

There are 16 parking bays available to disabled supporters in the Sainsbury's car park which is located directly next to the Stadium. These are available on a first come, first serve basis and can only be occupied on production of a valid blue badge.

By bus

Frequent bus services operate from all directions to the stadium.

By train

The nearest railway stations are Selhurst, Thornton Heath and Norwood Junction.

There are three train stations close to Selhurst Park:

- Norwood Junction (0.6 miles 13 minute walk)
- Selhurst (0.7 miles 15 minute walk)
- Thornton Heath (0.8 miles 19 minute walk)

All three stations are served by stopping services from both London Victoria and London Bridge or East and West Croydon stations. Norwood Junction is also served by the London Overground service via Canada Water and fast services from London Bridge.

Selhurst and Thornton Heath stations have step free access to all platforms.

Norwood Junction has step free access to Platform 1 for northbound stopping services only; there is no step free access to platforms 2-6.

Norwood Junction

The nearest railway stations are Selhurst, Thornton Heath and Norwood Junction

- platform 1 for northbound stopping services only (station staff assistance is available from first to last train everyday)

The nearest railway stations are Selhurst, Thornton Heath and Norwood Junction

Selhurst Station


- Step free access to all platforms with a long, steep access slope to Platform 1 for southbound services (station staff assistance is available from first to last train everyday)
- Occasional stops by some fast trains on platform 3 and 4
- Accessible WC on platform 1 (can be opened with a RADAR key)
- Bus stop within 25m with buses 75 and 157 to the nearby stop at Selhurst Road/Park Road

Thornton Heath

- Step-free access via lifts to all platforms (station staff assistance is available from first to last train everyday)
- Accessible WC on platform 2

There are no taxi ranks at these stations, but accessible taxis are available from East Croydon Station (2.2 miles), which is fully accessible.

All three stations are served by stopping services from both London Victoria and London Bridge or East and West Croydon stations.

Train Journey times - travelling from central London:

- London Victoria Southern trains go directly to Selhurst station, followed by a short walk (40 mins total)
- London Bridge Southern trains go directly to Norwood Junction station, followed by a short walk (30 mins total)
- London Waterloo Take any South Western train to Clapham Junction, then a Southern train to Selhurst station, followed by a short walk (45 mins total)
- London Kings Cross Take the Northern Line to London Bridge, then a Southern train to Norwood Junction station, followed by a short walk (50 mins total)
- London Euston Take the Northern Line to London Bridge, then a Southern train to Norwood Junction station, followed by a short walk (50 mins total
- London Paddington Take the Circle Line to London Victoria, then a Southern train to Selhurst station, followed by a short walk (60 mins total)



By Bike

We encourage supporters to cycle to the stadium when possible. Bicycle storage is available free of charge on request at the Information Centre, which is located by Entrance 9 and opens three hours prior to kick off.

Please note that, for safety reasons, e-bikes and e-scooters are not permitted within the footprint of the stadium.





ACCESSIBILITY

Fan Support Team and Accessibility Hosts

Our Fan Support Team are located at various points around the stadium and are on hand if you have any questions or are struggling to find your way around. They can be identified by their red coats and information pods.

There are dedicated Accessibility Hosts in all accessible viewing platforms and throughout the stadium who will be on hand to provide assistance, answer any questions you might have and ensure that you have a safe and enjoyable matchday at Selhurst Park. Our Accessibility Hosts are easily identified by their maroon tabards.

Disabled WCs and changing places

Accessible toilets are available throughout the stadium and there is a changing places facility in close proximity to the accessible viewing platform in the Lower Holmesdale Road Stand. A smaller changing area with a drop down table is available in the Main Stand.

Inclusion rooms

We have a Sensory Room at Selhurst Park which is fully accessible and located beneath the Whitehorse Lane Stand.

There is a larger Inclusion Room, with a view of the pitch, located in the Holmesdale Road stand, but unfortunately it is not accessible for wheelchair users because of its location.

Anyone wishing to use either room should prebook through our Disability Liaison Officer, dlo@cpfc.co.uk, however requests on the day may be accommodated subject to availability. Please inform our DLO or a nearby steward/ Accessibility Host should you need to use one of these rooms on the day.

Refreshments and service to seat

A member of staff will visit you in your location to take your refreshments order and deliver it directly to you.

Alternatively, there are bars and kiosks nearby with lowered sales counters and lap trays available for wheelchair users on request.

Audio descriptive commentary

Audio commentary is available throughout the stadium for supporters who are partially sighted or blind.

Anyone wishing to use the audio descriptive commentary service should pre-book through **dlo@cpfc.co.uk**, however requests on the day may be accommodated subject to availability.

Please inform our DLO or a nearby steward/Accessibility Host should you need to use this service on the day.

Emergencies

In case of emergency, our stewards/Accessibility Host will be on hand to direct you to safety. Please remain calm and follow their instructions.

ARRIVING AT SELHURST PARK

When you arrive

Once you arrive at Selhurst Park there are many things to do before you settle down to watch the match. There is a Fanzone in the main car park located by Entrance 10 which opens three hours before kick off and welcomes families with young children in possession of a valid matchday ticket.

There is also an opportunity for you to get an autograph/selfie from your favourite player, adjacent to the Information Centre, before they head off to the dressing room.

Our resident mascots, Pete and Alice Eagle, will also be out and about meeting supporters prior to kick-off and if you head to your seats early you will be able to watch players from both teams perform their pre-match warm up on the pitch.

The Away Fanzone opens two hours before kick off and a variety of food and drink is available.

Fan Support Team

Our Fan Support Team are located at various points around the stadium and are on hand if you have any questions or need help with finding a specific location. They can be identified by their red coats.

Box Office

The main Box Office is located inside the main Club Shop which is on the corner of Whitehorse Lane next to Sainsbury's. Matchday opening times vary depending on kick-off.

Please note that the Box Office closes during the game and re-opens at the final whistle for 30 minutes post-match.

Ticket collections

If you need to collect your ticket or require a reprint, please get in touch with your own club prior to matchday so that they can advise our Box Office team in advance.

The visiting supporter Box Office opens approximately two hours prior to kick off and is located on the corner of Park Road and Holmesdale Road, by Entrance 4.

Please ensure that you bring the required ID as you will be unable to obtain your tickets without it.

Club Shop

Selhurst Park has two fully accessible Club Shops open on a matchday. The main Club Shop is located on Whitehorse Lane by the car park entrance for Sainsbury's. We also have a shop in the Fanzone located directly outside Entrance 10, where there is also a shirt printing kiosk.

Bag restrictions

Supporters can bring a bag/backpack (small enough to fit under their seat) into the stadium, subject to a full search at the turnstiles. Alternatively, luggage can be left for free at the Information Centre which is located at Entrance 9. The Information Centre is open from three hours prior to kick-off until 30 minutes after the final whistle. Uncollected items are taken to the Main Reception.

Turnstiles

Turnstiles open two hours before kick-off. Full searches are carried out by CPFC stewarding staff prior to entry and supporters are urged to arrive at the stadium at least 45 minutes before kick-off in order to avoid delays upon entry.

Visiting supporters in home areas

Visiting supporters seated in any of the home sections of Selhurst Park will be dealt with immediately and ejected from the stadium by our security team for their own safety.

Flags and banners

We will do our best to accommodate requests for flags and banners to be brought into the stadium, but there is limited space for them to be displayed.

Supporters wishing to bring a flag or banner should send their request to Ben Collins, **ben.collins@cpfc.co.uk**, along with a full description and photograph (where possible) at least seven days before the game.

Please note that large flags and banners will only be considered if accompanied by a British Standards zero spread of flames fire certificate.

Motor bike helmets

Sniffer dogs are positioned at every turnstile and supporters found to be in possession of illegal substance or pyrotechnics will be handed over to the Metropolitan Police.

The following acts are classified as offences under the Football (Offences) Act 1991:

- Throwing objects within the stadium without lawful authority or excuse
- Indecent/racist chanting
- Entering the playing area or any adjacent area where spectators do not have permission to be

Any supporter partaking in these acts will be passed to the Metropolitan Police for prosecution and, if convicted, is likely to receive a banning order.

CCTV

CCTV Cameras are situated throughout the stadium and body cams that have audio as well as visual recording capabilities are worn by some stewards for the purpose of supporter safety and crime prevention.

In addition, we have had the Dallmeier camera system installed which is capable of capturing and recording all incidents in fine detail, including items as small as coins being thrown, inappropriate gestures/behaviour, flares being lit and thrown, and acts of violence.

The image quality generated by this system is second to none leaving club officials, the police and CPS in no doubt over who the offenders are.

In the event of a criminal act being committed, footage/still images captured by the club will be shared with the relevant authorities and may, subsequently, be used as evidence during court proceedings.

Abuse and antisocial behaviour

Crystal Palace F.C. is committed to promoting equality and diversity across the club including to its players, staff and supporters to ensure that all supporters have a safe and enjoyable matchday experience at Selhurst Park.

Racial/homophobic abuse, discriminating comments towards an individual/group of individuals and antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated. Supporters who are seen to be partaking in any of the above will be ejected from the stadium, may have their information passed to the police for prosecution, face having their Membership/Season Ticket suspended for a period of time or be issued with a banning order.

A text alert system is in operation on a matchday which can be used for reporting incidents of abuse and antisocial behaviour and enables the club to act on any information received in real time. The number to use is 07507 477 669 or +44 7507 477 669 from an international number.

Supporters can remain anonymous, but should include as much information as possible, including the type of abuse or antisocial behaviour as well as the exact location and any distinguishing features.

Any issues that are unable to be dealt with at the time will be followed up and investigated thoroughly by a CPFC staff member.





SAFEGUARDING

Children and young people

Children over the age of two years are welcome to attend Selhurst Park with parents or carers to watch a match.

Children over the age of 14 years can attend a match unaccompanied.

On Match days there is an Event Safeguarding Officer (ESO) who will be available to manage any arising incidents or concerns.

The visiting club will advise CPFC's Disability Liaison Officer and Event Safeguarding Officer of any supporters travelling to the game that may require additional safeguarding measures to be implemented.

Lost children

During a home game at Selhurst Park, if a child is reported as missing or presents as lost, the Event Safeguarding Officer (ESO) will be informed and support the Safety Officer, Club Stewards and Security to attempt to locate the child or the parent/carer.

If the child or parent/carer is unable to be located, the Club Police Liaison Officer will be informed.

Supporters are encouraged to use wrist bands, which are available from the information point (located by Entrance 9), to detail contact numbers, which would assist with locating parents/carers if the child becomes separated or lost.
