BOARD/COMMITTEE MEMBER WITH WELLBEING AND PROTECTION RESPONSIBILITIES

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

To lead wellbeing and protection by raising awareness of wellbeing and protection at Board/Committee level, championing children's rights in all decision making at the club and supporting the Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer to implement the Child Wellbeing in Scottish Football Policy and Procedures across the club by providing a direct link between the Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer and the Board/Committee

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Build a knowledge and understanding of wellbeing and protection in Scottish Football, including the club's Child Wellbeing and Protection Policy and Procedures
- Lead on the wellbeing and protection input at all Board/Committee meetings, providing the other Board/Committee members with updates on:
 - how the club is meeting the wellbeing and protection standards in Scottish football.
 - general information on wellbeing and protection in Scotland or Scottish football.
 - any relevant wellbeing and protection matters at the club.
- Ensure that the Board/Committee is supporting club officials to implement the wellbeing and protection standards across the club
- Keep up to date on wellbeing and protection through regular meetings/communication with the club's Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer
- Support the Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer to implement the Child Wellbeing and Protection in Scottish Football Policy and Procedures by providing a direct link between the Child Wellbeing and Protection Officer and the Board/Committee.
