How do I reserve the farm for my event?

What types of events can I hold at the farm?

Our farm hosts weddings, company retreats, family parties, reunions, and more! Our farm has a beautiful natural setting and is well outfitted for large or small groups, making it adaptable to a variety of occasions.

Are there any event packages available?

What accommodations are available at the farm?

The farm has various areas to stage your event: gorgeous fields of lavender and other botanicals, a spacious gazebo, a Medieval Village Inn, a show barn, and lots of beautiful, grassy lawns for your guests to enjoy. For seating and food preparations, we also have tables and chairs, kitchen access, and a walk-in cooler. Give your party a jolt of fun with a bounce house, children's medieval rides, a rock-climbing wall, and various concession amenities. With so many options, you'll have plenty of ways to please your invitees.

Am I required to use vendors from Young Living's preferred vendors list?

No. We offer our list of preferred vendors because we have found that they provide reliable, quality service. However, you may use any vendor of your choosing to provide food, flowers, and photography at your event.

Are there any other fees in addition to the event package price?

A deposit of \$500 is due upon reserving a date for your event. A \$250 non-refundable deposit and a \$250 refundable cleaning deposit are included in the price of each event package, so there are no additional fees.

Where is the farm located?

The Young Living Lavender Farm is conveniently located near I-15 at 3700 North Highway 91, Mona, Utah 84645; Exit 233 northbound and Exit 242 southbound.

Is parking available at the farm?

There is parking space directly next to the farm for over 100 vehicles. If additional parking is needed, please check with the Visitors Center manager for arrangements.

What is the farm's guest capacity?

Our farm can accommodate groups of fewer than 10 to more than 1,000 people. With multiple bathrooms, various hosting buildings, and grassy lawns, the farm can hold almost any size group.

Does the farm have any prohibited items or any rules or regulations I should know about?

Our farm rules and regulations are as follows:

- 1. Our business hours are Monday through Friday 8 a.m.–6 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m.–5 p.m., September to March. From April to August, our business hours are Monday through Friday 8 a.m.–8 p.m. and Saturday 9 a.m.–5 p.m. We're closed on Sundays and during public-facing events.
- 2. Arrangements can be made outside of these hours for an additional fee. We do not book events on Sunday.
- 3. Groups of 500 or more must have a permit; permitting fee will be applied.
- 4. Groups over 500 may require security, EMT, or vendor services; additional fees may apply.
- 5. No alcohol, smoking, or fireworks are permitted on the farm.
- 6. Trash and litter must be cleared and disposed of before leaving the farm. Garbage receptacles will be placed throughout the farm. If trash, litter, and/or food items are left on the farm, you hereby forfeit a portion or all of the \$250 refundable cleaning deposit.
- 7. Kitchens, walk-in coolers, and event space must be cleaned before leaving the farm and checked by your assigned farm contact to receive your \$250 refundable cleaning deposit. If you leave without contacting your farm contact, you will automatically forfeit the \$250 refundable cleaning deposit.
- 8. Any accidents or property damage must be reported to your assigned farm contact. If he/she is unavailable, please see Michelle Courtney at 1.801.418.8928 or mmartinez@youngliving.com.
- 9. Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
- 10. Dogs are allowed on park grounds but must remain on a leash while in the park, and owners will be responsible to retain control at all times.
- 11. The Young Living Visitors Center will stay open to the public during regular posted hours.
- 12. We reserve the right to book events on federal holidays and holiday weekends.
- 13. Event prices are subject to change.
