

How to obtain your Business Operation Permit in Expo City Dubai



Expo City Dubai

Business Operation Permit

Clients holding a valid Dubai mainland licence and wishing to operate temporarily or for a pre-determined period of time within Expo City Dubai (hereinafter known as ECD) may apply for an ECD Business Operation Permit (hereinafter known as a BOP). The ECD BOPs are available for a duration of one day up to twelve (12) months.

To obtain an ECD BOP, the client must submit the mandated legal documents to the Expo City Dubai Authority (hereinafter known as ECDA) and complete the steps below. ECD will assign each client an Account Manager to support and manage their permit journey.




Figure 2 Permit journey

STEP 1

The first step of the process requires the client to submit the ECDA Business Operation Permit application form along with the below listed documents to the designated Account Manager and complete full payment for the BOP. Controlled business activities are any activities that require additional approval from governing authorities. Such activities include, but are not limited to, food and beverage, alcohol and shisha service. Clients that will operate with controlled business activities will be required to submit additional documents and obtain approvals from relevant governing authorities.

STEP 2

The ECDA team will carry out a review of the submitted BOP application form and supporting documents. If additional approvals from government authorities are not required, ECDA will complete the review and issue the ECD BOP to the client.

For controlled business activities, ECDA will issue NOC letters to the relevant authorities to allow clients to obtain the necessary approvals.

STEPS 3 AND 4

Once the client submits to ECDA the necessary approvals from government authorities for any controlled business activities, the documents will undergo a final review and the ECD BOP will be issued.

ECD BOP requirements are subject to change and the client may be required to provide additional documentation to complete the permit process. Please refer to the latest requirements as set out in the 'How to obtain your Business Operation Permit in Expo City Dubai' guidelines.
