Expo City Dubai is also home to the world-class Dubai Exhibition Centre, a go-to destination for international events such as the Emirates Climate Conference with the UNFCCC (COP28).

This commitment to sustainability is embedded throughout the city, with solar panels and smart metering systems installed in all permanent buildings, each of which is certified by the prestigious LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) programme to ensure the highest environmental standards.

The 5G-connected city is also set to become a global business hub. International companies such as DP World, Siemens Energy, Siemens Industrial and Terminus are establishing a permanent presence in its dynamic freezone, as are a host of start-ups and small businesses.

And if you're simply looking to relax and enjoy yourself, Expo City Dubai is the ideal place to be. Hop off at the city's dedicated Dubai Metro station and you'll find yourself in the heart of the community with a plethora of leisure facilities, event venues, dining options, exercise grounds, retail outlets, green spaces and more.

Meanwhile, the bright young minds of the future will also find plenty to inspire them. The Expo School Programme is welcoming back school children from across the UAE to engage in entertaining and educational experiences galore.


VISION

Key Features

IDEALLY CONNECTED

Dubai is the gateway where East meets West – a place where people, languages, cultures and global commerce intermingle and thrive. Two-thirds of the world’s population can reach this truly interconnected destination within eight hours.

Expo City Dubai has its own metro station and is easily accessible from major highways. It is also close to Al Maktoum International Airport and within a one-hour drive of Dubai and Abu Dhabi international airports.

Expo City Dubai offers unparalleled digital connectivity, as the largest city in the world to be fully covered by a 5G-enabled network.

ROAD

- Easy access to four major highways: Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road, Sheikh Zayed Road, Emirates Road and Al Khail Road
- 30 minutes from Downtown Dubai
- Less than an hour’s drive from Dubai International Airport and Abu Dhabi International Airport

RAIL

- Connected to Route 2020 Metro Station on the Dubai Metro
- One stop from Al Maktoum International Airport
- 16 minutes from Dubai Marina

AIR

- Under eight hours flying time for two-thirds of the world’s population
- Adjacent to Al Maktoum International Airport

SUSTAINABILITY

Expo City Dubai is a blueprint for eco-conscious urban planning, on a journey to net-zero.

This clean and green city has 45,000 sqm of parks and gardens, its districts are fully pedestrianised (improving both safety and air quality).

Sustainability is at the heart of Expo City Dubai’s infrastructure. Waste has been minimised by retaining 80 per cent of Expo 2020-built structures, and more than 120 buildings are certified by the globally recognised LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) programme.

For anyone seeking a fresh perspective on our planet, and the urgent need to preserve it, a visit to Terra – The Sustainability Pavilion is a must. The structure is LEED platinum-certified, as it operates at the highest possible environmental standards.

State-of-the-art sustainability can also be found across all other buildings, which have solar panels installed as well as smart metering and sensors to monitor energy consumption and efficiency of power, light, water and climate conditioning systems.

Through these initiatives, Expo City Dubai targets a minimum 20 per cent reduction in energy demand in comparison to international standards.

EXPO CITY DUBAI ATTRACTIONS

Through its attractions, Expo City Dubai is also committed to addressing global topics and enabling people to share their voice, with a particular focus on the youth of today.

Al Wasl Plaza

Named after the Arabic word for 'connection', this iconic structure was the beating heart of Expo 2020 Dubai. Highlights during the six-month celebration included the opening and closing ceremonies, a sit-down chat with Cristiano Ronaldo and an incredible live concert by Coldplay.

There will be plenty more epic moments to savour at Al Wasl Plaza, as it continues to bring people of all backgrounds together at Expo City Dubai.


Its massive steel trellis dome, measuring 67.5 metres tall, acts as a 360-degree projection surface that you can view from both inside and outside – a mesmerising experience for anyone lucky enough to witness it.

Alif – The Mobility Pavilion

Step into a world of limitless connections and explore how mobility continues to transform the way we live, connect with people, understand different cultures and exchange knowledge and ideas.

You can also stand face-to-face with the awe-inspiring giants of Arab civilisation and learn all about the historic Emirates Mars Mission, whose Hope Probe orbited the red planet in 2021.

Designed by Foster + Partners, Alif – The Mobility Pavilion is a ribbed, curvy, three-sided structure wrapped in highly reflective stainless steel metal cladding, inspired by chrome fenders and aircraft wings.



Terra – The Sustainability Pavilion

Go on an immersive journey through the forest's roots and the ocean's depths to better understand the impact that humanity's choices are having on the environment – and gain skills to protect and preserve our planet for generations to come.

Designed by UK-based Grimshaw Architects, Terra – The Sustainability Pavilion has a 130-metre-wide canopy and 18 energy trees that help generate 4GWh of alternative energy per year, enough electricity to charge more than 900,000 mobile phones.



Vision Pavilion

Witness the great transformation of Dubai into a modern metropolis through the Vision Pavilion, a unique experience that celebrates the insight, values and leadership of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai. Through stunning displays, immersive exhibits and personal stories narrating the evolution of Dubai, the Vision Pavilion tells a story of childhood wonder and how our environment and values can support our ambition and shape our future.

Garden in the Sky

Garden in the Sky is a spectacular rotating observation tower that lifts visitors 55 metres above ground for beautiful panoramic views of Expo City Dubai. Earning its name from the trees that line the upper deck, the base of the tower beams with light at night, as do rings around the observation cabins, lending the attraction an out-of-this-world glow.



Women's Pavilion

Immerse yourself in the triumphs of women through history and delve into the inspiring stories driving change. The Women's Pavilion is a space dedicated to meaningful discussions that support women's contributions to shaping a more balanced world.



Surreal Water Feature

Behold a synchronised spectacle of water, fire and music in this enthralling experience. Surreal invites visitors to witness a gravity-defying feat of engineering, soundtracked by Game of Thrones composer Ramin Djawadi. See gushing water sweep over 18-metre curved walls and then seemingly flow upwards, while flames shoot into the sky.

Playgrounds

Little ones visiting Expo City Dubai have a world of extraordinary possibilities waiting for them across three unique playgrounds.

At Latifa's playground, children can learn about the planets and the universe. Meanwhile, young visitors can explore the seas at Rashid's playground, where they can have fun on whale slides, ocean liners and sharks on springs. Here, kids can also roam around the 3D maze, modelled after the majestic humpback whale.



The Adventurous Octopus playground, located outside of Terra – The Sustainability Pavilion, invites children to discover a series of exciting climbing routes up to the top of a 6.2-metre-tall structure, and roam through a mysterious maze filled with clouds of ink!


Stories of Nations




