Access an Interactive Biography

USC Shoah Foundation's <u>Dimensions in Testimony (DiT)</u> is an interactive biography that provides the opportunity to have a conversational experience with a genocide survivor or witness.

Interact with a survivor: Ask one of the following questions, or ask about another aspect of their experience you are curious to know more about.

Can you tell me about your childhood?

What was your life like before the war?

Where did you live during the Holocaust?

How were you separated from your family?

Which camps were you in?

What were the camps like?

What was the Holocaust like?

Tell me about liberation.

How were you liberated?

When did you first feel free?

How did you survive?

What was your life like after the war?

Where have you lived since the Holocaust ended?

What is your message for us?

Do you have a message for students?
