Talent Fest 2024 Rules and Judgement Criteria

1. Fancy Dress

- Make up & costume
- Theme
- Novelty
- Overall presentation

2. Creative Writing

- Introduction &Matter
- Structure & organisation
- Language & content
- Originality &conclusion

3. Miming

- Theme
- Acting skill
- · Variation of characters
- Clarity of message

Rules

- ✓ Minimum number of participants should be 8
- ✓ Participants should convey their message only through actions
- ✓ Participants cannot sing or speak
- ✓ Use of any masks or props is not allowed
- ✓ Sound effect without lyrics is allowed
- ✓ A short introduction of the theme of mime is allowed i.e. less than one minute.
- ✓ Message should be conveyed very clearly
- ✓ Time: 5 minutes

4. One Act Play

- · Selection of play & Theme
- Costume
- Acting skill
- Overall presentation

<u>Rules</u>

- ✓ Minimum number of participants should be eight for Grade 8 and six for Grades 9 to 12
- ✓ Plays should be from English Literature
- ✓ Appropriate Costume and Dialogue delivery should be carefully done
- ✓ There must be a minimum of 4 characters
- ✓ Background music can be played
- ✓ The plays included in the Syllabus are not allowed (Syllabus of the same class)
- ✓ Time limit: 4-10 minutes

5. Singing - English & Hindi (Solo)

- Lyrics & Selection of song
- Voice
- Melody & Clarity
- Overall Presentation

Rules

✓ Hymns are not allowed in English Solo

6. Group Singing (English) (Grades 9 to 12)

- Lyrics, Selection of song, Clarity
- Rhythm
- Involvement & coordination among participants.
- Uniqueness & overall

Rules

- ✓ Minimum number of participants should be 6
- ✓ No background music is allowed
- ✓ Participants who wish to wear similar costumes may do so (not compulsory)
- ✓ Time: 3-5 minutes

7. <u>Drawing & colouring /Pencil Sketching (Grades 9-12)</u>

- Relevance to topic
- Imagination & Quality of work
- Colouring (Sketching for Grades 9 & 10)
- Neatness, finishing & Clarity

8. Elocution

Elocution topic for Grade 8 will be '**Great Orators**' and Grades 9 to 12 will be informed of the topic 30 minutes prior to the competition.

- Introduction & Matter
- Pronunciation & Expression
- Voice Modulation
- Overall Presentation

(Topics will be informed five days in advance for Grades 3 to 7)

9. Quiz

- First round will be written for all students
- Top scorers from each class will be selected for final round.
- Topics: GK & Current Affairs, Sports, Movies, Music, Literature, Science, Social Science, Math & Logical Questions

10. Poem Recitation - English & Hindi

- Matter & Clarity
- Memorisation
- Body language, Rhyme & Rhythm
- Voice Modulation & overall

11. Debate

- Matter
- Presentation
- Argument
- Rebuttal session

Rules

- ✓ Time allotted for each speaker will be one minute.
- ✓ The speeches are to be memorised and presented.
- ✓ Following the first round of speeches there will be a rebuttal session for one minute per speaker
- ✓ Two speakers will be selected one for the motion & one against the motion from the class
- ✓ Decorum in language and action must be maintained

12. Folk /Cinematic Dance

- Selection of song/dance
- Steps & synchronisation
- Costume
- Expression

Rules

- ✓ Time: 3-5 minutes
- ✓ Minimum number of participants should be eight for Grades 5 to 8 and six for Grades 9 to 12
- ✓ Participants should wear descent costumes
- ✓ Decorum should be maintained in steps, dress and selection of songs
- ✓ Avoid obscene lyrics
- ✓ Participants should bring a copy of their song on a USB drive on the previous day of the competition

- ✓ Tooth picks may be used for support.
- ✓ Participants will need to bring fresh, dried or artificial flowers and a base for their arrangement
- ✓ Time: 40 minutes

16. Best out of Waste-Trash to Treasure

Participants should salvage trash/garbage deemed unusable and destined for the dustbin to create innovative and artistic creations

- Creativity / Originality
- Neatness / Quality of Workmanship
- Overall presentation

Rules

- ✓ Time: 40 minutes
- ✓ Avoid biological waste / waste with sharp edges
- ✓ Participants must adhere to the theme
- ✓ 2D and 3D models can be made on the mount board.
- ✓ Glue, pins, thread, ice cream sticks can be used to enhance the work

17. Vegetable Carving

Rules

- ✓ Pre-carved objects will not be allowed.
- ✓ Participants have to bring the required vegetables, fruits, tools and base plate for the competition.
- ✓ Only tooth picks can be used for reinforcement.
- ✓ Time 40 minutes

19. Hand Writing

- Letter Formation & Accuracy
- Neatness
- Correctness of spelling
- Overall Presentation

Rules

✓ Hand writing will be judged on the Cursive Form of writing

20. Doha Recitation/singing - Hindi

- Matter & Clarity
- Memorisation
- Body language, Rhyme & Rhythm
- Voice Modulation & overall presentation

✓ Choose any one - Raheem or Kabeer ke dohe

21. Word Formation

- ✓ 3 letter words and above.
- ✓ Singular and Plural forms of the same word will not be accepted. (eg. book books)
