- **Kindergarten & Grade 1:** 7th April 2026


Class Timings:

- **LKG:** 9:00 a.m. – 11:40 a.m.
- **HKG:** 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
- **Grades 1 to 5:** 8:20 a.m. – 12:40 p.m.
- **Grades 6 to 8:** 7:50 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.
- **Grades 9 to 12:** 7:50 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.

Please note the following important points:

- Timetables and other details for the online classes will be shared ahead of time.
- Many of you have already purchased the school diary, workbooks, and notebooks today. They will also be available for sale tomorrow as informed to you earlier. It is imperative that you read the diary and circulars carefully. Before in-person classes resume, please ensure that you fill in all required details on pages 3, 4, 159 and 160 with signatures and also complete pages 39 and 157 (if applicable). Paste recent coloured photos of your child in school uniform on pages 3 and 159.
- Update your current contact number and email in the Parent Portal.
- Always mention student's **Scholar No., Grade and Section** when communicating with the school.
- Fees can be paid at the school counter, any NEC branch, or via the NEC/BFC app (after current technical issues are rectified). Please tender exact change at the school counter to avoid delays.
- For students of Grades 9 to 12: Senior students will have classes on the first and third Saturday of each month. Initially, we will first start online classes on Saturdays for only Grades 10 and 12. Gradually, online classes will also begin for Grades 9 and 11. Once in-person classes resume, students of Grades 9 to 12 will continue with online classes on Saturdays instead of attending school in person, while weekday classes will be on campus.

We sincerely appreciate your patience, understanding and support during this time. Together, we can make this year a positive and rewarding experience for our students, even while learning from home.
