- \* Participants cannot sing or speak
- \* Use of any masks or props is not allowed
- \* Sound effect without lyrics is allowed
- \* A short introduction of the theme of mime is allowed i.e. less than one minute
- \* Time: 5 minutes
- \* Message should be conveyed very clearly

# 4. One Act Play

- Selection of play & Theme
- Costume
- Acting skill
- Overall presentation

# **Rules**

\* Minimum number of participants should be eight for Grade 8 and six for Grades 9 to 12

- \* Time limit: 4-10 minutes
- \* Plays should be from English Literature
- \* Appropriate Costume and Dialogue delivery should be carefully done
- \* There must be a minimum of 4 characters
- \* Background music can be played
- \* The plays included in the Syllabus are not allowed (Syllabus of the same class)

# 5. Singing - English (Solo)

- Lyrics & Selection of song
- Voice

- Overall Presentation

### <u>Rules</u>

\* Hymns are not allowed in English Solo

# 6. Group Singing (English) (Grades 9 to 12)

- Lyrics, Selection of song, Clarity
- Rhythm
- Involvement & coordination among participants.
- Uniqueness & overall

# <u>Rules</u>

- \* Minimum number of participants should be 6
- \* Time: 3-5 minutes

\* Participants who wish to wear similar costumes may do so (not compulsory)

#### 7. Drawing & colouring /Pencil Sketching (Grade 9-12)

- Relevance to topic
- Imagination & Quality of work
- Colouring (Sketching for Grades 9 & 10)
- Neatness, finishing & Clarity

## 8. Elocution

Elocution topic for Grade 8 will be '**Great Orators**' and Grades 9 to 12 will be informed of the topic 30 minutes prior to the competition.

### <u>Rules</u>

- \* Time allotted for each speaker will be one minute
- \* The speeches are to be memorised and presented
- \* Following the first round of speeches there will be a rebuttal session for one minute per speaker
- \* Two speakers will be selected one for the motion & one against the motion from the class
- \* Decorum in language and action must be maintained

# 12. Folk /Cinematic Dance

# <u>Rules</u>

- \* Time: 3-5 minutes
- \* Minimum number of participants should be eight for Grades 5 to 8 and six for Grades 9 to 12
- \* Participants should wear descent costumes
- \* Decorum should be maintained in steps, dress and selection of songs
- \* Avoid obscene lyrics
- \* Participants should bring proper USB of the song on the previous day

- \* Participants will need to bring fresh, dried or artificial flowers and a base for their arrangement
- \* Time: 40 minutes

# 17. <u>Origami</u>

- Neatness and precision
- Creativity
- Overall presentation

# <u>Rules</u>

- \* Time: 40 minutes
- \* Participants must adhere to the theme
- \* Participants need to bring the required origami sheets or gum art paper and base board for display
- \* No pre-folded papers will be allowed
- \* Glue can be used to paste the work on the mount board
- \* Both 2D and 3D models are allowed in your work
- \* Use of sketch pens or any other colouring medium will disqualify the participants

# 18. Best out of Waste-Trash to Treasure

Participants should salvage trash/garbage deemed unusable and destined for the dustbin to create innovative and artistic creations

# <u>Rules</u>

- \* Time: 40 minutes
- \* Avoid biological waste / waste with sharp edges
- \* Participants must adhere to the theme
- \* 2D and 3D models can be made on the mount board
- \* Glue, pins, thread, ice cream sticks can be used to enhance the work
