Warm greetings from The Asian School.

Following a period of online learning during exceptional circumstances, our students continued their education from home with resilience and commitment. While every effort was made to ensure continuity and quality in virtual learning, we acknowledge that it cannot fully replicate the richness and engagement of in-person classroom experiences.

We are pleased to inform you that as the situation has now largely normalized, it is both appropriate and beneficial for students to resume regular on-campus schooling. As previously communicated, **in person classes for students from LKG to Grade 12 will commence on 4th May 2026**. We extend a warm welcome to all our students and look forward to seeing them back on campus, reconnecting with their friends and teachers.

Parent-Teacher Meeting (Online)

To strengthen collaboration and support each child's progress, the first Parent-Teacher Meeting of this academic year will be conducted online as scheduled below. Class Teachers will be in touch with details.

- KG to Grade 8: 16th May 2026
- Grades 9 to 12: 17th to 25th May 2026

(Kindly note: Grades 9 to 12 will continue to have regular online classes on 9th and 16th May 2026)

Transport

School buses will operate as usual. Students not using school transport should be collected from the designated waiting rooms. LKG to Grade 4 students must be collected personally from the Waiting Room or Bus Stop. Students of Grades 5 to 12 who are not being personally collected from the Bus Stop or Waiting Room need to complete the Unescorted Students Travel Permission Form (School Diary Pages 39 and 157).

Non-bus students must be collected before 2:00 p.m. from their waiting rooms without fail.

Classroom Allocation

- Grades 9 to 12 will move to the Main Building this academic year
- Grades 4, 5 and Sections A to F of Grade 3 will be housed in the Extension Block

Important Instructions

- Parents are requested to ensure that pages 3, 4, 159, and 160 of the school diary are duly filled. A recent passport-size photograph must be affixed on pages 3 and 159.
- Students should bring books according to the revised timetable, which will be shared shortly.
- Students must attend school in proper school uniform.
- Physical Education uniform should be worn on designated days (please refer to School Diary Pages 8-12 for details on uniform and general appearance).

The much-anticipated Talent Fest is rescheduled and will now be conducted from 13th to 18th June 2026.


Sports Events
