Dear Parents,

Summer Vacation will commence on **Sunday, 29th June 2025**, after regular school hours. Classes will resume on **Saturday, 6th September 2025**, for Grades 9 to 12 and **Sunday, 7th September 2025**, for KG to Grade 8. It's a wonderful time for children to have fun, reconnect with family and friends and indulge in their favourite hobbies. The holidays provide an opportunity for recreational activities, relaxation and joyful celebrations, offering a break from our usual daily routine.

In today's education, the development of skills such as communication, collaboration, and leadership have become integral to the all-round development of a child. Therefore, we highly encourage our students to focus on honing these skills during the vacation period. Additionally, we strongly emphasize the importance of nurturing artistic talents in all forms. Students have been assigned small projects and subject enrichment work, which should be completed during the course of the summer holidays and submitted on or before **Sunday, 14th September 2025**.

During the summer holidays, the school office will remain open from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. from Sunday to Thursday (Fridays and Saturdays will be holidays).

Tuition Fee Increase and Outstanding Fee Dues

The Tuition Fee for LKG to Grade 10 will be revised from BD 39.6 to BD 43.5 per month, in the new Academic Year starting in April 2026 to offset our increase in rental costs, facility improvements, technology enhancements and increased maintenance demands.

Parents are requested to clear all outstanding fee dues (if any) immediately. If dues are not cleared on time, defaulters' names will be struck off the school register. For more details, please refer to Page nos. 6 and 7 of the school diary. Fees can be paid at the school office, via NEC app/branch or via the BFC app. Those who wish to apply for a transfer certificate, should apply online before Sunday, 29th June 2025, and collect them on Monday, 30th June 2025. No transfer certificates will be issued during the holidays.

School Transport Facility

If you wish to discontinue the school transport service from September 2025, please submit a cancellation application by **Sunday, August 24th 2025**, at the latest. Similarly, if you wish to avail the school transport service starting September onwards, please submit an application for availing school transport, by **Sunday, August 24th 2025**. Applications forms should be submitted to transport@asianschool.bh.

Please review the contents on pages 12 and 18 of the school diary, which outline the rules and regulations concerning general appearance and uniform guidelines, among other things. It is important to ensure that students comply with these rules when they return to school, particularly regarding ear and nose piercings, hair colouring and unacceptable haircuts. Any violation of these rules will be treated seriously and appropriate action will be taken. It is imperative that you update your email ID's in the parent portal.

We encourage children to make the most of their holidays by engaging in productive activities, so they can feel refreshed and ready to return to school in September with renewed energy and good health for an exciting new term. Students appearing for Board Examinations are required to put in their best effort for the forth coming examinations. Half Yearly Examinations will begin by the end of September.
