We are delighted to inform you that our school will be celebrating **Book Week** from **15th to 23rd October 2025**, an annual event designed to instil a lifelong love for reading and literature in students. Book Week offers children the chance to explore the joy of books, appreciate the art of storytelling, and understand the power of imagination and knowledge that reading brings.

In today's technology-driven world, nurturing the habit of reading is essential as it enhances vocabulary, improves concentration, sparks creativity, and develops empathy. Through this celebration, we hope to inspire every child to see reading not as a task, but as a journey of discovery.

During this week-long celebration, a variety of programs have been planned to emphasize the importance of reading and vocabulary development.

In addition to engaging competitions, students will receive **three new words daily**, complete with definitions, synonyms, antonyms, and usage examples. Furthermore, they will explore the **lives and works of two different authors** each day, fostering familiarity with their contributions to literature.

Following competitions based on the theme 'Every Image tells a Story' are scheduled for **Grades 3 to 12**.


Grades 9 to 12	Picturization of Shakespeare in 2025	• Redesign two of Shakespeare's timeless characters through a 2025 lens
Grades 6, 7 & 8	Literary Collage	• Create a collage on the theme 'World of Books' • Use drawings, sketches or any other creative medium
Grades 3, 4 & 5	Bookmark Creation	• Design unique bookmarks inspired by favourite books or themes • Bookmarks should be functional and measure 7.5 cm x 20 cm

General Rules:

1. The artwork must be an original creation of the student.
2. It should be drawn on **A4-size paper** with a clear and legible title.
3. Submissions must include the name of the book that inspired the artwork.
4. **Medium:** Colour pencils.
5. Each entry must include the student's scholar number, name, grade, and section.
6. The **deadline for submission** is **23rd October 2025**.
7. Certificates will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners of each grade if all criteria are met.
8. The judges' decision will be final.

Let us work together to cultivate a generation that reads, reflects, and rejoices in the world of books.
