Dear Parents,

As per the recommendations of NEP 2020, CBSE has introduced the two Board Examination Policy.

Under this policy, Grade 10 students will be given an opportunity to improve their performance in up to three subjects during the Second Board Examination scheduled in May 2026


Please note the following conditions to appear for the Second Board Examination.

1. It is mandatory for all the students to appear in the First Board examination 2026.
(However there has been a relaxation for this rule for us due to the current situation.)
2. All passed and eligible students are allowed to improve their performance in any of the three subjects out of Science, Mathematics, Social Science and Languages.
3. Subject change is not allowed from First examination to Second examination.
4. No correction in the student's data from first examination to second examination is allowed.
5. The Second Board Examination will be conducted based on the syllabus of the First Examination meant for the year.
6. For the Second Board Examination, once the examination center is allotted, it will not be changed.
7. Students who wish to appear for a Second Board Examination, should submit LOC during the 2nd phase as stated below to help CBSE in advance preparation. For students in the Middle East whose examinations were cancelled, can decide based on the declaration of result and then pay the examination fee.
8. Even after submission of LOC and payment of examination fee, if any student decides not to appear in the Second Board Examination, performance in the main examination will be used for declaration of result.
9. An examination fee of BHD 13/- will be charged per improvement subject.
10. A Google Form will be sent immediately after the First CBSE Board Examination result is announced. Students can fill the form and submit the payment for subjects they would like to improve upon.
11. Once the form is sent, students will have **ONLY 3 days** to submit the form and make the payment as the school will then need time to compile the data, submit the LOC and make the payment to CBSE.

The Schedule for the submission of the LOC is as follows:
