### **BOOK WEEK**

The school will be celebrating Book Week from May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The week will kick-start with a captivating **BOOK FAIR** which will be hosted at the Dr. Abdul Kalam Memorial Auditorium on the Parent Teacher Meeting Day ie. Friday May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024. The Book Fair will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m, offering parents and students a wonderful opportunity to explore and purchase a diverse selection of books.

During this week-long celebration, a diverse range of programs have been curated to instil in students the importance of reading and the development of vocabulary.

In addition to engaging competitions, students will receive three new words daily, complete with definitions, synonyms, antonyms and usage examples, to enrich their vocabulary. Furthermore, they will discover the life and work of two different authors each day, fostering familiarity with their contributions to literature.

Grades 3, 4 & 5	Cartoon Drawing	•	Cartoons should be based on popular fairy tales or superheroes

## General Rules:

- 1. The Artwork must be an original creation by the student.
- 2. It should be drawn on A4 size paper with a clear and legible title.
- 3. Submissions should include the name of the book that inspired the artwork. Please ensure that the title of the book is clearly stated along with your entry.
- 4. Medium: Colour Pencils.
- 5. Each entry must include the student's scholar number, name, grade and section as per school records.
- 6. The deadline for submission is Sunday May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- 7. Certificates will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners of each grade if the above criteria are met.
- 8. Judges' decision will be final.

We encourage you to inspire your child to participate enthusiastically.
