Dear Parents,

The last working day this term will be the day just before the Ashoora holidays begin. We will inform you of the exact dates as soon as they are announced. On the last working day of the term, students will also celebrate **Crazy Hair Day**, a fun-filled activity where they are encouraged to come to school with creative, colourful, or imaginative hairstyles, adding a touch of excitement and cheer before the summer break.

School will re-open after the summer holidays on Wednesday, 2nd September 2026. The holiday period is a valuable time for students to relax, rejuvenate, and reconnect with family and friends. It offers a welcome break from the regular academic routine, allowing them to pursue their interests and hobbies while engaging in recreation, personal growth, and meaningful experiences.

At the same time, to ensure continuity in learning, a thoughtfully designed holiday learning programme has been assigned. During the summer holidays, the school office will remain open from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. from Sunday to Thursday. Parents are requested to clear all outstanding fee dues (if any) immediately. If dues are not cleared on time, defaulters' names will be struck off the school register as detailed in page nos. 6 and 7 of the school diary. Fees can be paid at the school office and via NEC app/branch. Parents applying for a Transfer Certificate should **do so online before Thursday, 18th June 2026, and collect it on Tuesday, 23rd June 2026.** No transfer certificates will be issued during the holidays. It is important to keep your contact details updated so the school can reach you for timely communication regarding important announcements, emergencies, or any information regarding your child.


