Certificates and medals will be awarded to the top three participants from each category. The deadline for registration is Tuesday, 17th September.

The selection round for the competition will take place on Thursday, 26th September, with shortlisted candidates presenting their products or services on Saturday, 5th October.

Competition Judging Criteria:

1. Teams must consist of four members: one from Humanities, one from Commerce, and two from the Science stream.
2. Each team member's contribution must be clearly demonstrated.
3. Students should present a model of their product along with visuals to explain their service.
4. Presentations may include slides, audio, video, etc.
5. The proposed product or service must be eco-friendly and sustainable.
6. Time limit: 5 minutes per presentation.
