Books

Every student must procure and carry the diary to school daily. Pages 3, 4, 159, 160 and 37, 157 (if applicable) of the diary must be filled carefully and completely before the first day of school. The last page is retained by the school and the information therein is used for any emergencies, so please ensure correctness of the data entered.

Fees

Please be informed that fee collection at NEC and BFC has been stopped and the service will resume after 1st April 2024. In the interim, fees can only be paid at the school counter.

Fees for the new academic year can only be paid after 1st April 2024 as the transition to the new year can be done in our system only by then. Therefore, fees for the new academic year cannot be paid on the result days.

After 1st April, parents are required to pay the Annual Fee of BD 18/- for LKG to Grade 6, BD 36/- for Grades 7 & 8 and BD 48/- for Grades 9 & 10, along with the Tuition Fee of BD 39.600 (for LKG to Grade 10) for the month of April 2024. If availed, the Transport Fee of BD 15/- and Computer Fee of BD 5/- must also be remitted.

Grade 12 students who received scholarships in Grade 11 will continue to receive the benefit only if they have secured 75% aggregate in Grade 11. Tuition fee for the other Grade 12 students will be BD 82.500.

Parents are reminded that fee payments must be remitted before the 10th of every month without fail.


The results of fee defaulters will not be declared on the result day and will be withheld until all outstanding fee dues till March 2024 have been paid. Defaulters paying AY 2023-24 arrear fees after April 1st will need to mandatorily remit April 2024 fees also along with the arrears. Sections for the next AY will not be allotted to defaulters as we will have to assume that they do not wish to continue at The Asian School, and hence they will be unable to attend classes in the next AY.

Uniform

Parents are reminded that the new P.E. uniform will be mandatory in the new academic year and must be worn on days when the student has a P.E. class. The new uniform colour is based on the house allotted to the student which will remain unchanged during the scholastic life of the student in the school. The white P.E. uniform strictly cannot be used anymore.

Miscellaneous

Students going on long leave must submit a hard copy of a written/typed leave application at the school office and fees must be remitted in advance. Henceforth, applications for long leave by email will not be considered.
