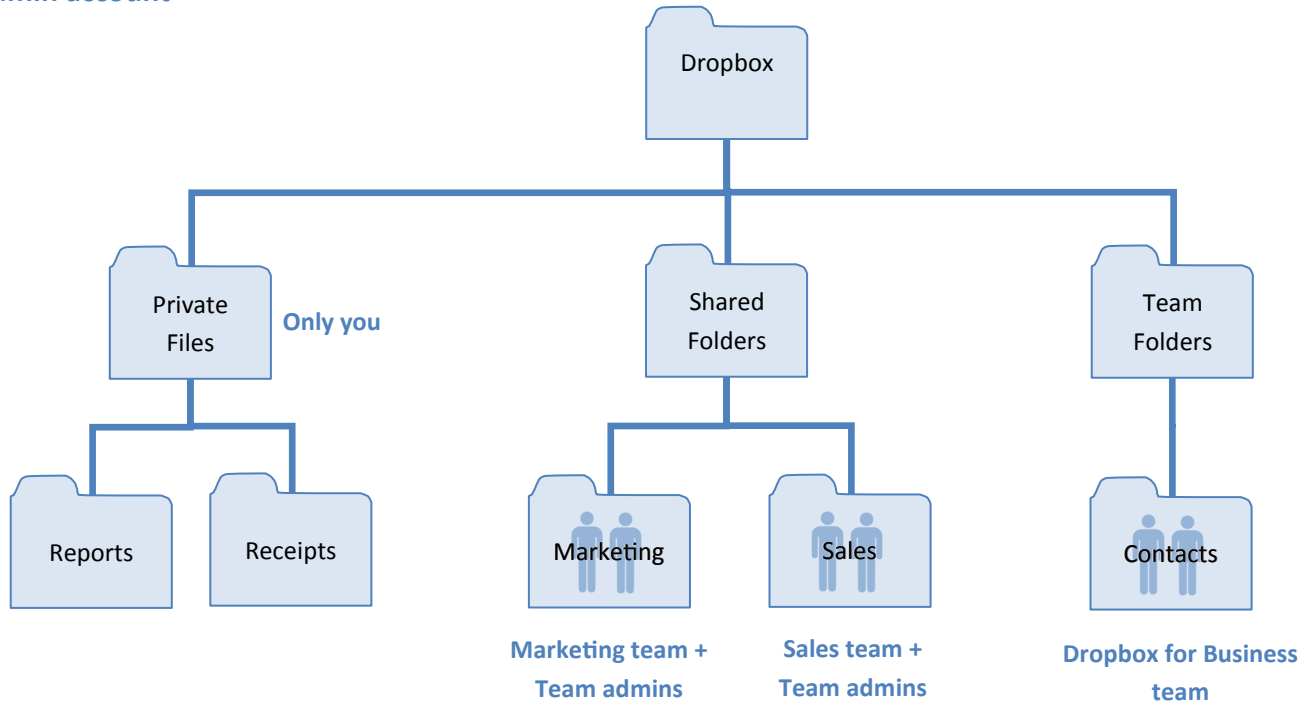


Multi-department Dropbox for Business team

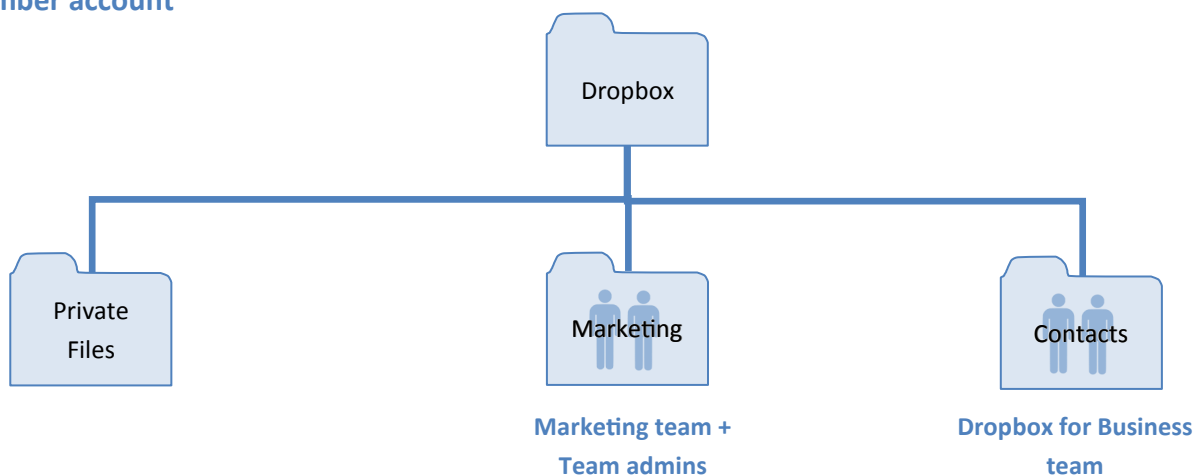
Admin account



This is how the Dropbox account of an Admin of a Dropbox for Business team that includes both the Marketing and Sales departments may look like.

The marketing team only needs access to the Marketing shared folder, and the sales team only needs access to the Sales shared folder, but the administrators of this Dropbox for Business team need access to both, so they're members of both of these shared folders.

Team member account

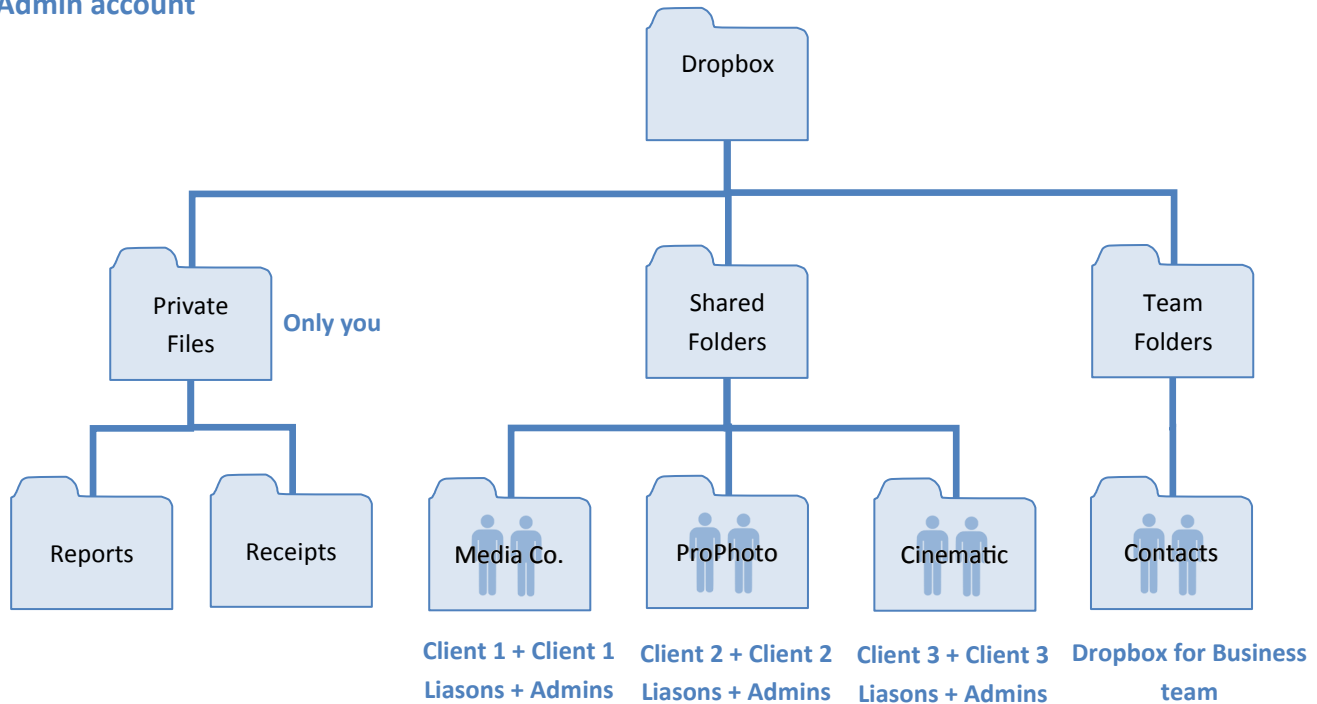


This is how the Dropbox account of a member of the marketing team may look like. Note that they don't have access to the Sales folder, but they do have access to the Contacts folder, since this is a team folder.

Dropbox for Business team that works with clients or contractors



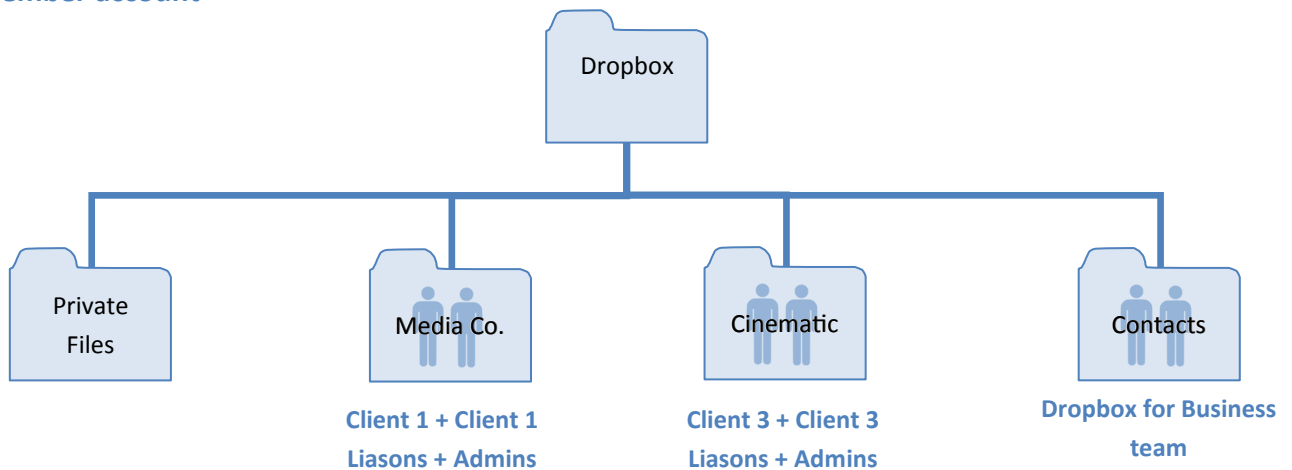
Admin account



This is how the Dropbox account of an Admin of a Dropbox for Business team that works with multiple clients might look like.

In this team, certain employees work on certain projects, but don't work on all of them. There is a shared folder for each client, and only the client, the employees who need access to the folder, and the admins of the Dropbox for Business team have access to the folder.

Team member account

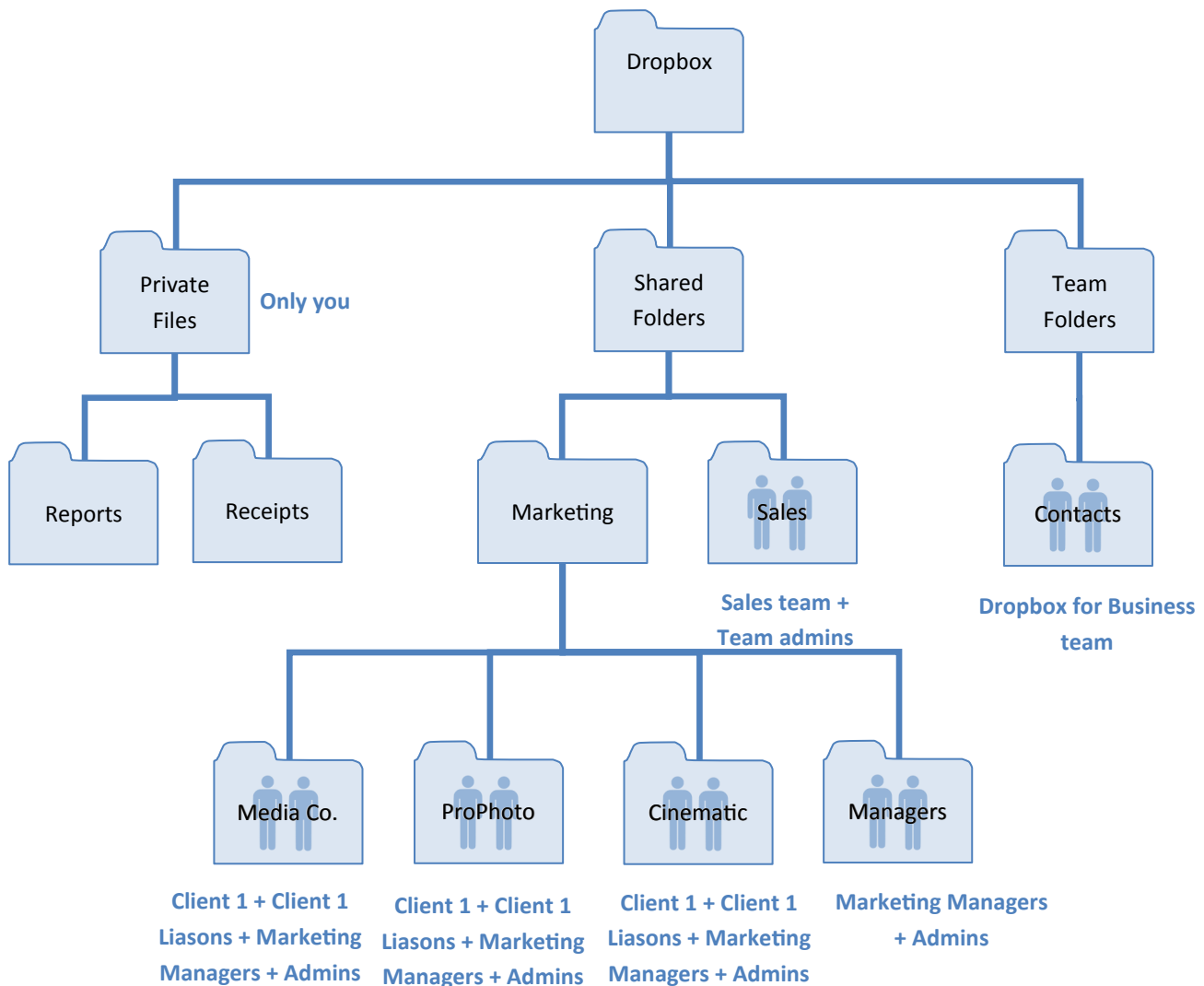


This is how the Dropbox account of one of the team members may look like.

As you can see, this team member happens to be working with both Media Co. and Cinematic, so they have access to both of these shared folders. They aren't working on the ProPhoto project, so they don't have access to that shared folder.

A combination of the last two...

Admin account



This is the Admin Dropbox account for a Dropbox for Business team that has a more complex organization. Not only does this team include the Marketing and Sales departments, but the Marketing team also works with external clients.

You'll notice that in addition to the client shared folders, the managers of the Marketing team also have their own shared folder. This shared folder might include reports, performance reviews, or other files that the managers of the Marketing team need to share and have access to, but that the rest of the marketing team do not require access to.
